

#### NEW CUTBACK IN ALUMINUM INGOT ORDERED

WASHINGTON, Sept. 2- (UP) - A new cutback in aluminum ingot production was ordered by the War Production board as a result of greatly decreased war needs. Cutbacks in production of airplanes, which use large quantitles of aluminum, obviously were

Production will be pared down 30,000,000 pounds monthly, leaving it at 90,000,000 pounds a month, sufficient for present milttary and civilian needs. The peak output was reached last winter when production was at the alltime high of 188,000,000 pounds The new cutback is expected to

release about 1,000 workers in eight plants, four of them government-owned and the other four owned by the aluminum company of America. Meanwhile the War department

announced that it had ordered, large-scale production of aluminum airplane landing mats, consisting of 10 - foot - long 15 - inch - wide "planks" which lock together to form a portable airfield for use in China, Burma and the Pacific
