YOUNGSTOWN, O., Sept. 25—(AP)—A 13-year-old boy from nearby Campbell admitted juvenile authorities here when he told of hiring two other boys as bodyguard after he had taken \$1,300 from his father.

The boy was questioned by Campbell police after the father, a huckster, said he thought money had been disappearing from his home.

Police Chief John Oshelski of Campbell told court officials that the boy confessed taking the money over a four-month period. He spent money lavishly, Oshelski said, hiring one bodyguard for \$5 a week and another for \$20 a week. The boy bought two saddle horses at a riding stable, bought a bicycle for one of his bodyguards and purchased two wrist watches.

Juvenile Court Judge Henry P. Beckenbach paroled the youth to the father, who said he did not want to press charges.
