

ENGLAND HAS MORE BABIES LESS WEDDINGS

LONDON, Sept. 38-(UP) . The stock continued to work overthme in England and Wales during the first three months of this year, a tabulation of the Resistrar-General's records shows. In the first quarter of 1944 there were 14,145 babies born, a figure which represents a birthrate of 17.9 per 1,000 population, the highest quarter rate Since 1926 Hut Cupid's arrows apparently

went wide of their mark in the same puriod. The number of marriages was the second lowest for any quarter since the war, the the rate is still slightly higher than that of prewar years. Up to March 31 this year 62,-599 couples were married. This number exceeds by only 262 the
