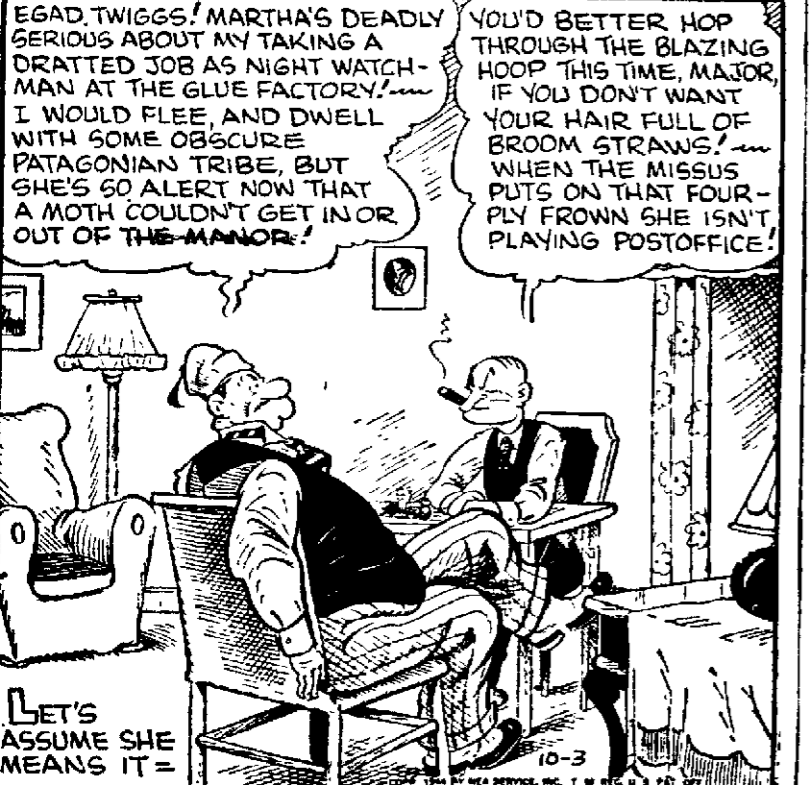
"Those were the good old days!" This phrase and many other words used to the same effect can be heard these days and for the younger generation, it may sound a little like Greek.

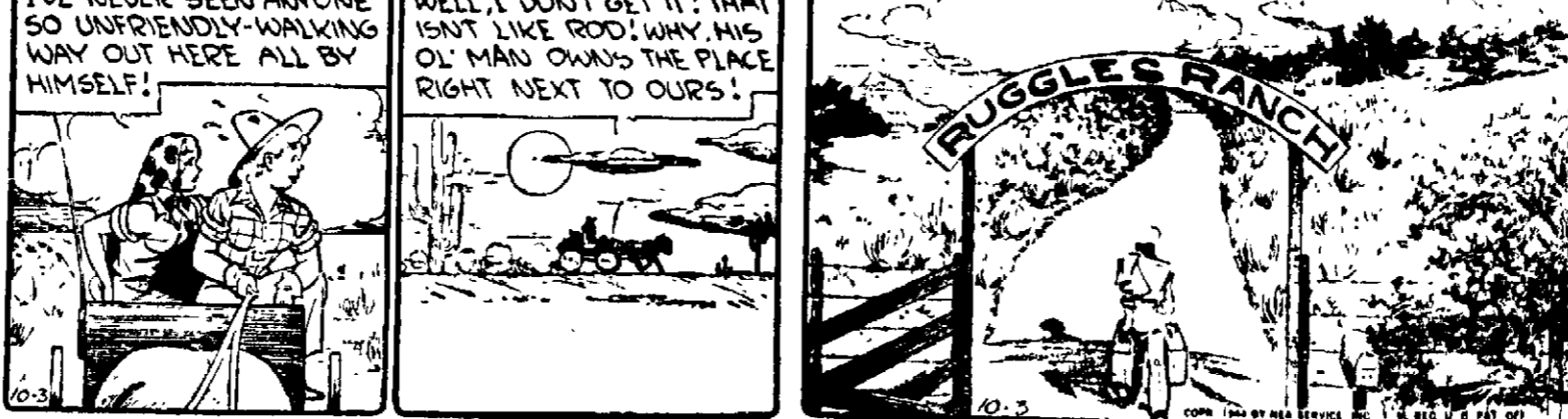

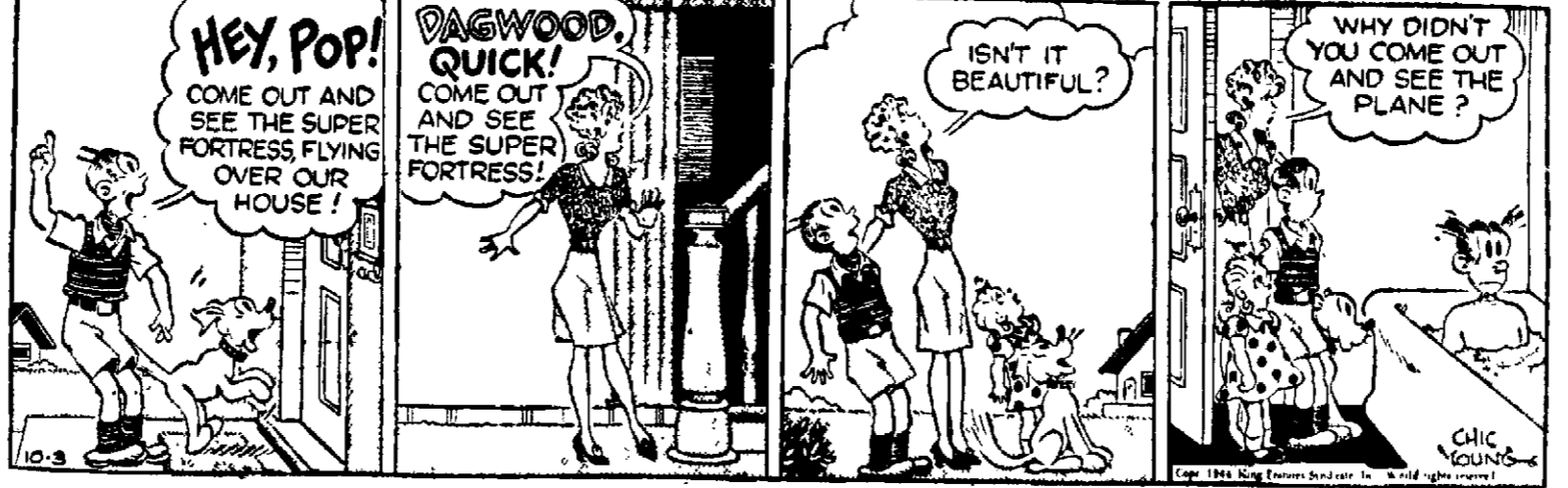

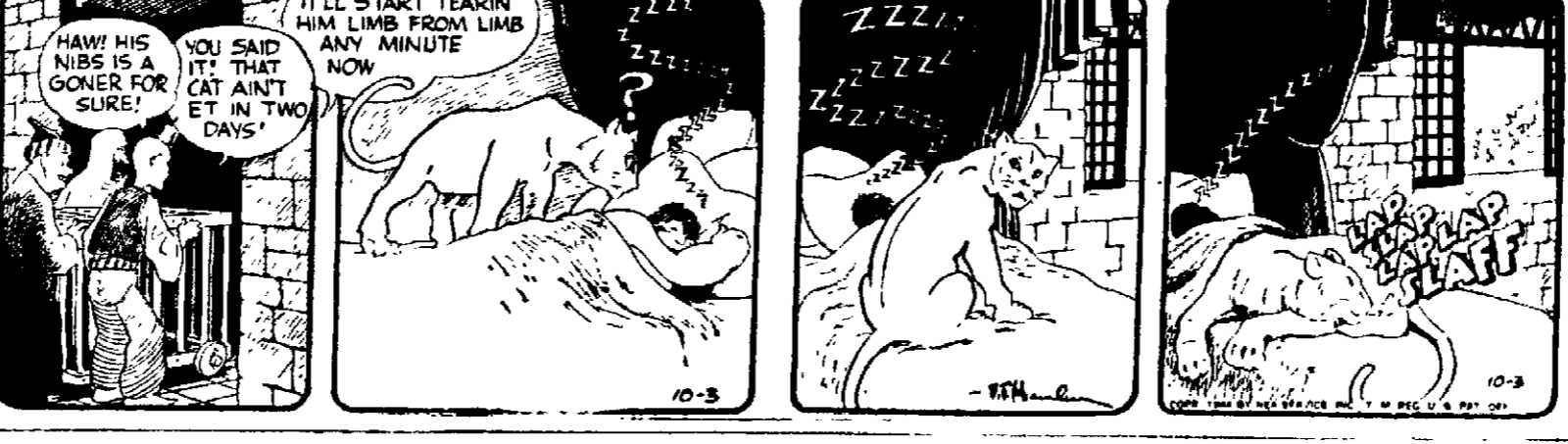
