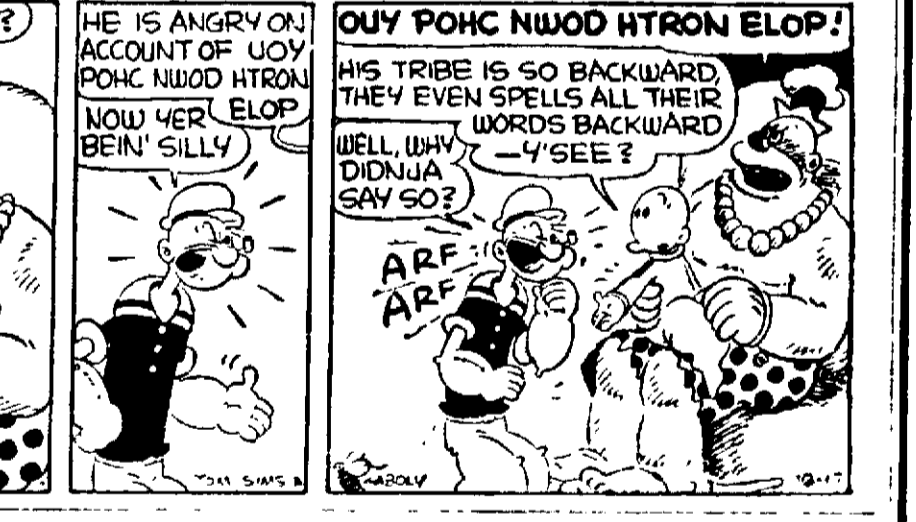

BOOST SET ASIDE OF CANNER BEEF

WASHINGTON, Oct. 17—(AP)—Meat packers operating under federal inspection were instructed today by the War Food Administration to set aside 80 per cent of all canner and cutter beef for government procurement.

The order, effective tomorrow, is similar to a set-aside regulation in effect Jan. 30 to April 30, suspended when sufficient canning beef became obtainable for war requirements.
