SPANISH BORDER TOWN OCCUPIED BY GUERRILLAS

NEW YORK, Oct. 30—(INS)—The German radio said today that Spanish guerrilla forces from the south of France have occupied the semi-independent state of Andorra on the Franco-Spanish border and have assumed power there. The broadcast reported by the OWI, gave no further details.

Andorra has a population of 5,200 and an area of 191 square miles. The tiny state, situated between the Central and Eastern Pyrenees under an arrangement dating back to medieval times was obligated to pay annual dues of 980 francs to France and 160 pesetas to Spain.

Surrounded on all sides except the southwest by mountain peaks rising as high as 10,000 feet its principal industry is tobacco growing. Language of its inhabitants is Catalan.
