The department pointed out Georgia Gibbs, singer, and Roy however, that dividends and interest earnings chalked up for the first nine months of this year -\$7,500,000,000 - fell about a billion dollars short of the 1929 figure for the same period.

Commerce officials said that individuals earned \$81,750,000,000; in salaries and wages in the first nine months of 1944, again more than doubling the figure for the equivalent period of 1929.

Total income payments in the month of September, 1944, were \$13,500,000,000. Of this figure, \$9. 250,000,000 were paid out in salaries and wages and \$1,250,000,-000 in dividends and interest.

The September salaries and dividends topped those of the preceding month of August, the department said, and estimated that workers earned \$72,000,000 more in salary and wages, and that investors gained about a billion dollars more in dividends and interest in September than they did in August.


