

# Use Of Force To Keep Peace To Be Debated On Broadcast

The question whether our membership in a world security organization should deprive congress of its constitutional right to declare war will be debated on "America's Town Meeting of the Air," when four prominent speakers debate the topic, "Should the American Representatives in a World Organization Have Power to Commit Us to Use Force?" in the broadcast Thursday at 7:30 p. m. over Station WJZ.

Sen. Claude Pepper (D-Fla.), a member of the Senate Foreign Relations committee and a leading pre-Pearl Harbor spokesman for the cause of intervention, and Sen. Joseph H. Ball (R-Minn.), member of the Senate Committee on Appropriations, argue that for prompt action against aggressors, power to employ force should be delegated to our representatives in a world council. Sen. Chapman Revercomb (R-W Va.), member of the Senate Military Affairs committee, and John T. Flynn, lecturer, economist and author, make the opposite viewpoint. George V. Denny, Jr., is moderator.

## DRIVE TO OPEN WITH AUCTION IN PUTNAM-CO

OTTAWA, Nov. 16—The Sixth War Loan will be launched in Ottawa and Putnam-co Monday with a gala war bond auction, it was announced today by Albert Klausning.

The auction will be conducted by Cash Johnson and Danny Ryan, widely-known auctioneers of this

section who also will sell bonds at two other auctions next week on behalf of the Sixth War Loan. The Oak Restaurant will be the site for the affair.

Klausning announced the goal of the auction here as \$100,000 worth of bonds. He held a similar auction near the close of the Fifth War Loan and over \$30,000 worth of bonds were sold in the establishment.

Merchants of Ottawa are being asked to donate prizes to be awarded for various bond purchases.

The total REA rural electrification loans for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1944, amounted to approximately \$33,800,000, the U. S. Department of Agriculture stated.

Bondholders will get started on their work in the Sixth War Loan through the county Monday with the goal for Putnam-co set at \$1,240,000.

Johnson and Ryan will conduct an auction of bonds at the Flamingo restaurant in Defiance Tuesday and in the Continental Hotel Wednesday.

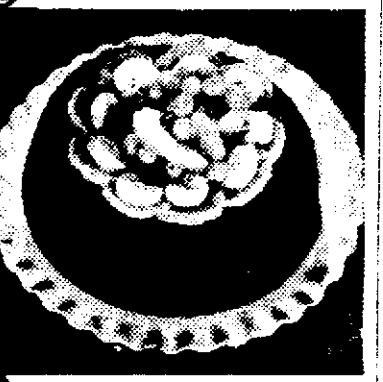

### New Orleans Molasses Ring
