

UNIFICATION OF AMERICA'S AIR FORCES URGED

OKLAHOMA CITY, Nov. 20 (AP) - A resolution asking unification of America's air, sen and land forces under a single executive department was one of 19 adopted today at the closing sesion of the second national aviation **cl**ínic.

The delegates went on record as favoring first priority for municipalities in the acquisition of surplus military air fields after the war and stressed extension of aviation benefits to smaller cities and

They approved flight experience for high school students and aviation training for returning soldiers and sailors, and came out for preservation of "private ownership and management of air services operating under reasonably-regulated competition."
