

Tuneful Spotlight Scandals Movie Now Showing At Lyric

There's a world of entertainment and some top calibre performances in "Spotlight Scandals," the tuneful, colorful musical film that opened Sunday at the Lyric theatre.

Based on a well constructed story and strengthened by the deft direction of William Beaudine, this is a picture that should score a 10 strike with any audience. "Spotlight Scandals" is exactly what the public is demanding these days—

pure entertainment with no mention of international intrigue, post-war planning or fifth columnist. Henry Travers, expert and veteran character actor to be seen importantly in "The Very Thought of You" now playing at the Ohio theatre, must have found his role pleasantly familiar. It's the kind of part he does so engagingly. In this new picture, Travers plays the congenial head of a family which might charitably be tagged unorthodox. Its provocative members include an emotional mother, a cynical son, another equally cynical daughter, a peace-making daughter-in-law, and a prematurely sophisticated teen-age child.

Every new motion picture made in Hollywood is, upon completion, shown to the Army for overseas selection as a gift film in 16mm size for exhibition in combat areas and isolated posts. Only the motion pictures sent there are said to be almost as good morale builders as letters from home.

COLLEGE CHIEF ASKS FACILITIES FOR SERVICEMEN

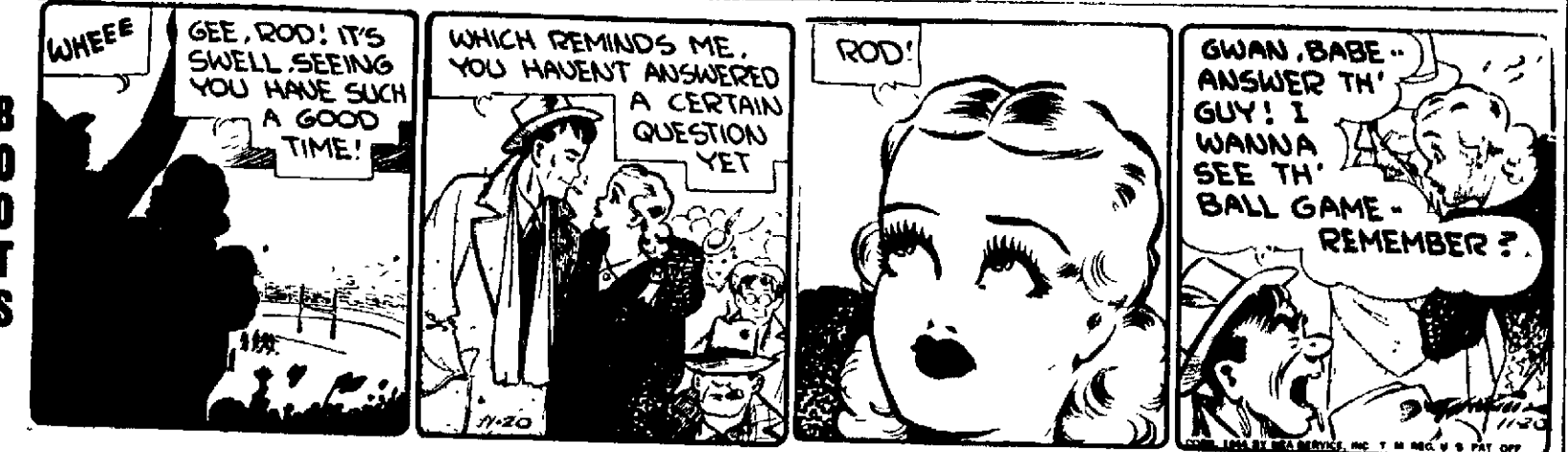
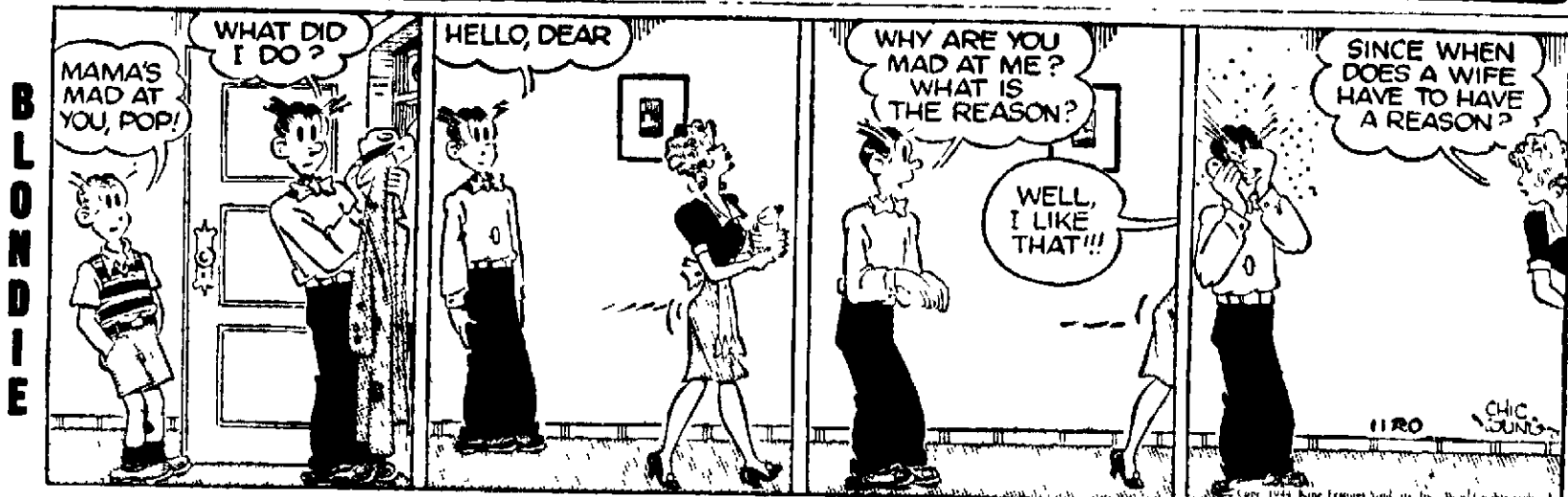
KENT, O., Nov. 20 — (AP) — George A. Bowman, inaugurated as Kent State university's fifth president today, advocated ample institutional facilities to provide higher education for returning servicemen.

"Every physical plant will be overtaxed," he declared. "This is why I am so concerned that we be permitted to get underway without further delay with the preliminary planning of our much-needed additions and improvements to our physical plant.

"If we have to turn away returning veterans from our public institutions, it will make a mockery of our generous provisions for their education."

Bowman said the Kent faculty already had formulated plans for veterans' courses of studies and would be prepared for any swift change of student needs and demands upon the university.

PRISONERS GET FILL OF RESTRICTED DIET

OMAHA, Nov. 20—(AP)—Italian prisoners of war returned to their jobs at Army installations here today after "deciding they had enough of the restricted diet" imposed yesterday, the Seventh Service Command announced.

The dispute, which began Thursday over "Italians' objections to certain working conditions" at Fort Crook near here, spread to a large army laundry and the command's ordnance shops. The army said "several hundred" Italians were involved.

The restricted diet, which did not include their beloved spaghetti, was administered under army medical officers' supervision to protect the prisoners' health.

UNIFICATION OF AMERICA'S AIR FORCES URGED

OKLAHOMA CITY, Nov. 20 — (AP) — A resolution asking unification of America's air, sea and land forces under a single executive department was one of 19 adopted today at the closing session of the second national aviation clinic.

The delegates went on record as favoring first priority for municipalities in the acquisition of surplus military air fields after the war and stressed extension of aviation benefits to smaller cities and towns.

They approved flight experience for high school students and aviation training for returning soldiers and sailors, and came out for preservation of "private ownership and management of air services operating under reasonably-regulated competition."

The "unified national defense" resolution asked that "each of the defense forces be administered separately within the overall department in order to preserve freedom in progressive development, to preserve the valuable traditions of the services x x x and to afford a correct estimate of the value of each service."

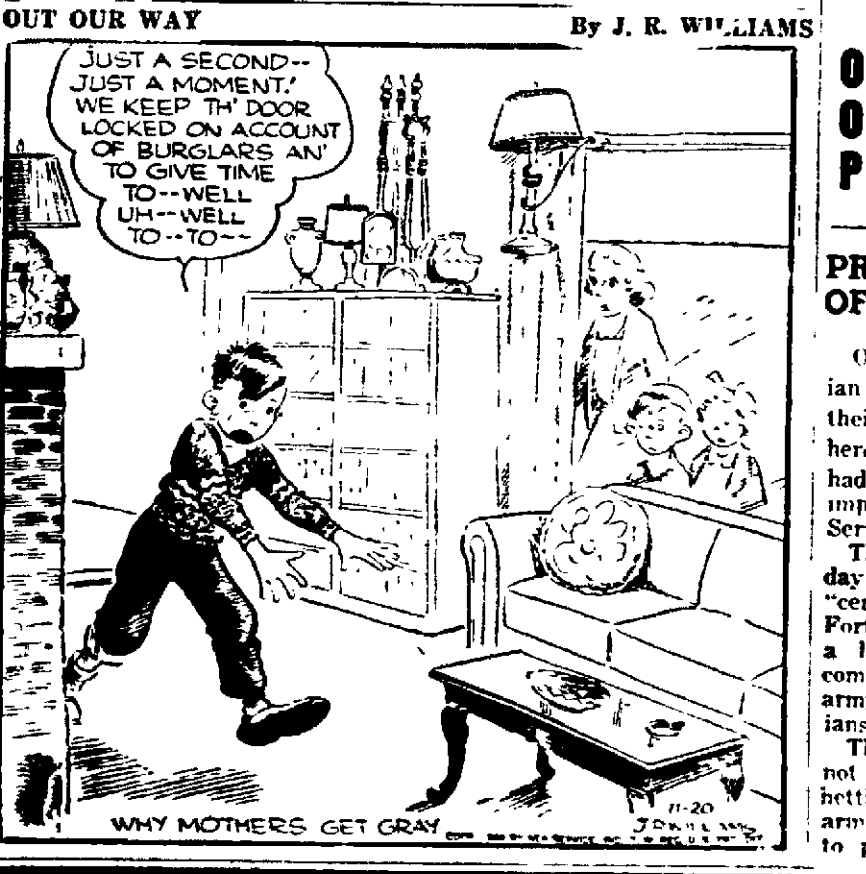
