ico City. "The Song of Mexico" will be done in both languages, for the North and South American markets, under direction of James Fitzpatrick, hitherto noted for his film travels. Adele, formerly a brunette, hails from Dearborn, Mich., is Spanish-Irish in descent, and her real name is Adelaide Delgado. Like Margo, Lina Romay, and Marissa Flores, she was formerly an entertainer with Xavier Cugat's orchestra, where she was discovered for pictures. At Columbia she appeared opposite Joe E. Brown and Chester Morris, but made only three pictures in two years. Her career was accelerated when she joined Republic and appeared in nine films in six months—finally winning her chance to sing and dance in this good-neighbor film.
