DEMILLE GETS FOURTH VICTIM COURT ORDER TO HALT UNION BAN

HOLLYWOOD, Dec. 9.—(UP)—Cecil B. DeMille today prepared to go on the air in his next regular Monday night radio show under a temporary restraining order to keep the American Federation of Radio Artists from banning his \$5,000-a-week broadcast because he refused to pay a \$1 political assessment.

DeMille filed suit for an injunction to prevent the union from forcing him off the air by suspending him from the union and Superior Judge Emmet H. Wilson issued the temporary order. Judge Wilson ordered the AFRA representatives to show cause why the injunction should not be permanent at a hearing Dec. 15.

DORSEY ACTION IS DISMISSED

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 9.—(AP)—Judge Arthur Crum has dismissed the assault charges against Tommy Dorsey, his wife, Pat Dane, and their neighbor Allen Smitley growing out of an attack on Jon Hall.

The court said it had been reluctant to take the case from the consideration of the jury but felt that under the state of the record it would be an abuse of its judicial discretion not to do so. Judge Crum referred to one of the state's principal witnesses, Antonio Icaza, Panamanian actor, as a "fabulous, masterful fabricator of falsehoods, a perjurer pure and simple, demonstrated innumerable times out of his own mouth."

Ellery is invited to hang around to see that a young multi-millionaire doesn't die by midnight. The death is doubtful, but a fortune hangs in the balance.

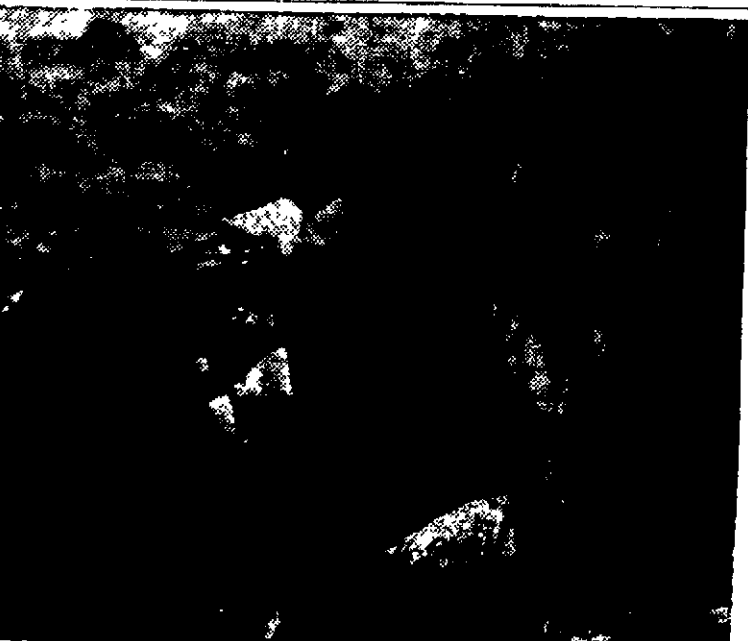

AKRON TRANSIT WORKERS WILL STRIKE MONDAY

AKRON, O., Dec. 9.—(AP)—Maintenance men of the Akron Transportation Co. will strike at 2 a. m. Monday, a spokesman for the AFL International Association of Machinists said today as officials of the CIO Transport Workers Union expressed willingness to work out a settlement in a threatened strike in the rubber capital's transportation system.

D. Lyle Mahan, AFL business agent representing the mechanics, said 110 employees would walk out unless demands for increased pay denied by the War Labor Board last October were met. Bus drivers and street car operators voted earlier to strike next Monday in an effort to secure similar pay increases, but William H. Wright, CIO local president said "we still are willing to work out a solution."
