400 EVACUATED IN U. S. HOSPITAL SHIP

WASHINGTON, Dec. 11—(AP)—More than 400 patients were embarked on the hospital ship U. S. S. Mercy when she moved in close to a Leyte beachhead in the early days of the Philippine invasion, the Navy disclosed today.

The situation, the Navy added, was made precarious by air raids and landing operations as well as by the proximity of Japanese naval units.

The Mercy was the first hospital ship to take part in the Philippine action.

ALLIES PROBE ITALIAN BLAST

ROME, Dec. 11—(AP)—Allied authorities are investigating a bomb explosion at an Italian recruiting station in Teramo the night of Nov. 29, the same night that manifestos appeared in the town urging youths not to enlist because the Italians were "a conquered and destroyed people."

Two youths were taken into custody after the bombing, which smashed a wall of the station, but no charges were lodged against them.

GROUP TO REVAMP POLITICAL PARTIES

BUENOS AIRES, Dec. 11—(AP)—The Argentine government announced today the appointment of a three-man committee to draw up a statute governing political parties.

The decree under which the committee was created said "it is the intention of the government to return to normalcy as soon as possible" and to "restore to the citizens their political rights."

In order to assure a true democratic regime, the decree added, it is imperative to "improve the electoral system as well as eliminate political corruption and fraud."

Robert Louis Stevenson's mystery classic, "The Bottle Imp," is given a contemporary setting in a "Mystery Theatre" dramatization Tuesday at 8 p. m. over WEAF.

To dramatize that really great stories could have been put in any setting in any age, Geoffrey Baines, connoisseur of mystery fiction and host of the "Mystery Theatre," takes Stevenson's classic, which employs Hawaiian characters in an 18th century setting, and projects the plot to 1944, with a New York City locale and present-day characters.

Gary Cooper and Joan Bennett have been cast by Producer Cecil B. DeMille to star in the Radio theatre version of the comedy "Casanova Brown," Monday. The full-hour dramatic show is heard regularly Monday nights at 8 p. m., over WABC.

CHARGES NAZIS DRUG CAPTIVE TO GET FACTS

BERN, Dec. 11—(AP)—The Swiss newspaper Journal de Geneve said today the Gestapo is using Dr. Karl Goerdeler as a guinea pig to extract from him forcibly confessions which form the basis for the arrests of dozens of prominent Germans opposing the Nazi regime.

The former mayor of Leipzig, arrested in connection with the plot to slay Hitler, has not been executed, but has been given drug injections daily and then has been submitted to questioning, the newspaper declared.

As a result of the induced statements several industrialists and scores of other important men have been arrested, De Geneve's story said.

The newspaper reported also that Gestapo Chief Heinrich Himmler in his efforts to rout out all opposition has ordered hanged or beheaded more than 200 lawyers and intellectuals in the environs of Berlin alone.

SOVIET AND FRENCH AVIATORS HONORED

MOSCOW, Dec. 11—(AP)—France and the Soviet Union bestowed high honors today on French and Russian airmen who served on the eastern front.

In a ceremony held in the grand salon of the French embassy, Gen. De Gaulle presented orders and decorations to 11 Soviet officers and 43 members of the French Normandie air regiment.

Earlier Soviet Air Chief Marshal Novikov pinned the gold star of the hero of the Soviet Union on two Normandie aces and distributed the patriotic war order of the Red Star on 17 other Frenchmen.

HELMETS TO BE SOLD

COLUMBUS, O., Dec. 11—(AP)—The Columbus district Office of Price Administration announced today that the Treasury department's procurement division would sell more than 300,000 safety helmets, purchased originally for air raid wardens, at a ceiling price of \$1.10 each. The wholesale price was 75 cents each, the OPA said.
