

State Theatre Presents Outstanding Double Bill

Two of the most exciting movies to be placed on celluloid are opening Thursday at the State theatre under the title of "Summer Storm" with Linda Darnell and "Canterville Ghost" starring Charles Laughton. While "Summer Storm" shows the treacherous side of life, "Canterville Ghost" depicts the humorous happenings which take place in an ancient castle. What happens from there is anybody's guess.

Laughter is given priority rating in Nunnally Johnson's "Casanova Brown" now showing at the Ohio theatre. Gary Cooper has the role of Casanova who on the eve of his wedding to Maige Ferris (Anita Louise) learns that he is the father of a child of a previous marriage to Isabel Drury (Terese Wright). Fun runs riot from there on in.

Part of the quality of good acting depends on how realistically a certain mood is portrayed. But when the acting becomes too realistic, trouble springs up as it did for Director Otto Preminger, during the filming of "Laura." Amateur sleuths may see the movie and try to detect the spots where too much realism might have ruined the picture. "Laura" now is showing at the Quilna theatre.

The film which now is playing at the Sigmata theatre under the title of "Our Hearts Were Young and Gay" with Gail Russell and Diana Lynn and Gail Russell, is just about the funniest comedy to reach the screen in a long while. Describing quite simply the actual experiences of two precocious young debutantes who are permitted to make an unchaperoned trip to Europe. "Our Hearts Were Young and Gay" embraces all the hilarious situations into which two beautiful innocents might walk on their first thrilling visit to Paris.

Murdered Laundry Truck Driver In Strange Mystery

A missing laundry truck, a murdered driver and a valuable cuckoo clock all help to make up the strange mystery which "Mr. and Mrs. North" try to untangle in "The Norths and the Cuckoo Clock" on Wednesday at 7 p. m. Lima time, over Station WEA.F. On their way out to the laundry truck to complain to the driver about poor service, the Norths call off the complaint when they find the driver dead! Then the truck disappears... and so does the cuckoo clock, a valuable antique, owned by a neighbor. Before long, everything reappears, but the Norths still have a strange case on their hands.

LONDON, Dec. 13—British elder statesman David Lloyd George, who will be 82 next January, has decided to spend the evening of his life in the Welsh village where he lived as a boy.

London, the House of Commons, and his fine country home at Churt in Surrey County, near London, will see very little of him from now on.

With his second wife, his former secretary whom he married this year, he will make his main home at Ty Newydd Farm, in the village of Llanystumdwy, near Criccieth, Wales.

The man who was British premier from 1916 to 1922 has decided "it is not a bad thing for a man to spend his last days at home." Mentally he remains a giant but he has not been well and looks frail.

As "father" of the House of Commons, he hopes to retain his membership until he dies, and it is likely he will not be opposed when he seeks re-election for Caernarvon, which he has represented continuously since 1890, at the general election next year.

Richard Lloyd, his uncle and the village cobbler, took Lloyd George to Llanystumdwy after the death of his schoolmaster father. The Lloyd George farm is only a few yards from the cobbler's shop, where he lived as a boy. The single village street remains virtually unaltered from when Lloyd George first knew it.

The formal birth of the United Nations was the adoption in Washington, D. C., on Jan. 1, 1942, of the "Declaration by United Nations."
