The ships were made available to the Army and Navy by the Merchant Marine.

In speaking of the Merchant Marine's part in building up the hospital fleet, Frank J. Taylor, president of the American Merchant Marine Institute, pointed out that in 1939 only one hospital ship was in service, and that it was fortunate that the vessels could be made available by the nation's shipping.

The average hospital ship has about 600 beds and is the equivalent of a seven to nine story hospital covering a small city block. Leading the fleet are three former world cruise liners, the President Madison, the President Bu-chanan, and the President Fill-
