# Plans Fight On Working Gals

COLUMBUS, Jan. 5—(UP)—Tuscarawas-co's bachelor legislator—Patrick J. Dunn—today prepared to again take up his legislative cudgel against working women.

Dunn, his red hair a little more grey but his fiery spirit unquenched, admitted there is little he can do to return women to their "rightful place" in the home as long as the war is in progress.

But the 68-year-old Democratic representative whose seven consecutive terms set a new assembly record has some definite ideas for the post-war period.

And there's a better-than-even chance that they'll receive a cool reception from the ladies who prefer the typewriter to the skillet. Dunn is accustomed to scorn from that corner, however. He suffered it in previous campaigns against working women and female cigaret smokers.

"I don't have any definite legislation in mind right now," Dunn said, "but there's a good possibility that later on I'll introduce a bill which would force Ohio employers to discharge women whose husbands have good-paying jobs."

"The President said that we must provide 60,000,000 jobs after the war. Well, here's a way to provide a lot of them. There's no reason in the world for a married woman to work when her husband is bringing home a good paycheck every week."

Dunn said it will be necessary to return women to the home from their jobs in warplants and offices to provide job opportunities for Ohio's returned veterans.

"There's one thing certain," he said, "Our boys aren't going to return to relief lines or corner apple stands. They're going to demand jobs—good jobs. And it's going to be up to the legislature to see that they get them."

# U. S. CASUALTIES TOTAL 556,352 UP TO DEC. 21

WASHINGTON, Jan. 5—(INS)—Secretary of War Stimson disclosed today that American army casualties total 556,352 as of Dec. 21, but this figure does not include the casualties sustained in the German drive on the western front.

The total included 103,991 killed, 326,127 wounded, 66,567 missing and 59,667 prisoners of war. Stimson explained that it was not possible under the circumstances of the battles now taking place in Belgium to make an accurate report of casualties. He said that it would be some time before such report would be forthcoming.

He explained that in a "retirement" the problem of counting casualties is made extremely difficult for the officers on whom the data depends since the casualties must be left in the territory of the advancing enemy.

### OHIO DEMOCRATS OPPOSE DIES' BODY

WASHINGTON, Jan. 5—(AP)—Ohio's six Democratic Representatives voted against making the committee on un-American activities permanent in a house vote yesterday while the Republicans split 10 to 4 in favor of the measure.

Republicans for the proposal were Clarence J. Brown, Cliff Cleveland, Charles Elston, P. W. Griffiths, William E. Hess, Thomas Jenkins, Robert F. Jones, Edward O. McCowan, J. Harry McGregor and John M. Vorys.

George Bender, Frances Bolton, Earl Lewis and Homer Ramey, Republicans, voted against the measure. Not recorded were Republicans Frederick Smith, Walter E. Brehm and Alvin E. Weichel.
