

#### Uncle Ray's Corner JUPITER COMPARES WITH EARTH AS ORANGE DOES TO CHERRY

Yesterday I gave figures about the planets and their diameters. Today let's compare them to certain well known objects. Let us start with the earth, and

suppose that it is the size of a cherry. In that case, Venus also would be the size of a cherry, but a slightly smaller cherry.

Uranus and Neptune could be represented by small peaches (if you had them at this season). Oranges could be used for Jupiten

That, in a rough way, shows the relative sizes of the nine planets. If you would like to be more exact about the matter, you could cut disks from paper, using a compass to make your circles.

In preparing the disks, let us use a scale of one inch to 16,000 miles. In that case, the disk for the planet Jupiter should be five and one-half inches wide.


