STATES URGED TO BOOST PAY FOR JOBLESS

CHICAGO, Jan. 15.—(AP)—The council of state governments recommended today that the 44 state legislatures meeting this year revise their unemployment compensation laws to bring benefit payments up to a maximum of \$20 a week for a maximum of 26 weeks.

The council's report on unemployment compensation in the post-war period said such maximums would sustain an adequate standard of living for workers and their families for a reasonable period of reconversion and minimize deflationary effects of unemployment.

A \$20 maximum now is provided in nine states, California, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Utah, Wisconsin, Wyoming and Connecticut; a \$15 maximum is provided in 21 states and \$18 in 14 states, the council reported.

Other council suggestions were that legislatures consider whether coverage should be extended to employes of small businesses, to major groups in agricultural processing industries and to maritime workers.

Thirty-one states have reduced the waiting period for compensation to one week, only three limit any one year's benefits to less than 16 weeks, 20 have limits above 16 weeks and 12 provide a maximum of 20 weeks or more, the council reported.

MAN IS SAVED AFTER BEING BURIED BY COAL

WATERTOWN, N. Y., Jan. 15.—(AP)—Chester E. McCallips, 25, was rescued today by 10 men who shoveled him from beneath 10 tons of buckwheat coal.

McCallips was trapped after he slid down an 18-inch chute while shoveling coal. Unconscious when extricated, he was revived and taken to a hospital where he soon was discharged.

McCallips was loosening the coal in an upper part of the bin when he slipped and became wedged in the chute. The jar of his fall caused the rest of the coal to slide atop him, but he was able to breathe the air which reached him from below.

A workman below looked up when the flow of coal stopped and saw McCallips' feet dangling from the chute.

SOVIETS CITE ATROCITIES BY GERMAN TROOPS

MOSCOW, Jan. 15.—(AP)—Red army correspondents made new charges of atrocities by the German garrison in Budapest today, asserting that women and children were used as shields by infantry in their counterattacks. "Hundreds of bodies of civilians already have been dug up by Soviet sappers under the ruins of buildings blown up by the Germans. They not only neglected to warn the tenants, but did not permit them to leave their flats or shelters," wrote the correspondent of the Moscow News, V. Mariansky. "Streets not directly within the line of fire also are being wrecked by the Germans. On Nepsainbazst in Pest (eastern half of the city) they sent tiger tanks to fire at houses whose occupants had refused to dig trenches. "During the past two days, the Germans have been resorting to their old trick of advancing behind groups of women and children."

COMMONS WILL OPEN DEBATE ON WAR THURSDAY

LONDON, Jan. 15.—(AP)—The government announced today it had decided to hold full-dress debate on the general war situation a week earlier than previously planned, and this led to speculation that a date already had been set for the impending conference of the "Big Three."

Prime Minister Churchill will open debate next Thursday with his report to commons reviewing the war and the Greek crisis, and the debate will continue thru Friday.

With President Roosevelt's inauguration Jan. 20, there is little or no chance of the "Big Three" meeting before then, but there is a general feeling here that the President, Churchill and Marshal Stalin of Russia will meet either late this month or early in February.

Britain's whole military and diplomatic position faces a full airing after the return of commons from the holiday recess Tuesday.
