A \$20 maximum now is provided in nine states, California, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Utah, Wisconsin, Wyoming and Franklin P. Adams and John Connecticut; a \$15 maximum is provided in 21 states and \$18 in 14 states, the council reported.

Other council suggestions were that legislatures consider whether coverage should be extended to employes of small businesses, to major groups in agricultural processing industries and to maritime workers..

Thirty-one states have reduced the waiting period for compensation to one week, only three limit any one year's benefits to less than 16 weeks, 20 have limits above 16 weeks and 12 provide a maximum of 20 weeks or more the council reported.
