

young man in Denmark named Tycho Brahe. He was at that time, 25 years of age, and he had studied to be a lawyer. Yet his mind was Tycho Brahe a month before his twenty-sixth birthday. The next night he looked again, and the new star was still there. Again and again, as the weeks and months less on the law than on the stars.

Tycho Brahe lived before the day of the telescope, and he studpassed, he saw it, and there was a period when it was the brightest star in the sky. Then, after a period of 16 months, it faded away. ied the stars without that instru-ment. He made maps of the sky,

and knew the places where hun-dreds of stars could be found. On a November night in 1572, this young star-gazer looked at the star group known as Cassiopeia. Whether or not he rubbed his eyes, we are not told, but there his eyes, we are not told, but there in that constellation was a star which he never had seen before scopes and photographs, it has been possible to observe such

events more easily.
On an evening in February, 1901, an astronomer saw a new star in the group known as Per-seus. Only the night before a photograph of that section of the sky had been made, but close study of the picture showed no

As the days and weeks passed, the new star in Perseus grew brighter and brighter. At length it became the brightest star in the

Before this new star faded away, tests were made to discover its distance. These tests showed that it was so far away that light from it would take about 120 years to reach us.
Going back 120 years from 1901,

we find that the event which made the new star must have happened about the year 1781. Perhaps the star "exploded," making it much brighter. It is possible, however, that the brightness came from two stars smashing into each other.
