Luzon is the largest of all. In 1939 it has a population of 7,374,-000. Its area is 40,814 square

Along with Luzon and Mindanao, those islands have 90 per cent of the people and 95 per cent of the land in the Philippines, The natives of the Philippines, have the general name of "Fili-pinos." There also is a special use of this name, which gives it to the more civilized residents, and not to the savage tribesmen. The 1939 census showed that slightly more than 16,000,000 per-sons lived on the islands in that year. Only about 15,000 of these were whites. 
