Locher succeeds Ralph Klapp of Columbus, who resigned to become an assistant attorney general a month ago. Locher, associated with the Cleveland law firm of Davis and Young, will take over duties of the \$4,600 post immediately.

Locher, nephew of the late Cyrus Locher, a former state commerce director, attended the University of Dayton and Bluffton college prior to entering the Western Reserve Law school. He was graduated from Western Reserve and admitted to the bar in 1939.
