OES To Study Fringe Cases

WASHINGTON, Feb. 10 (AP) — A War Labor Board proposed compromise in the "Battle of the Fringe"—how to handle industrial wage adjustments not involving general wage increases—was before the Office of Economic Stabilization for approval today.

Backed unanimously by the board, the new policy suggests that Stabilization Director Fred M. Vinson referee fringe cases as he does general wage changes ordered by WLB.

The board would try to keep the smaller adjustments within "stabilization limits" to forestall price increases. A two-month deadline on the issue between the WLB and OES has held board decisions on several industry wide cases including those of the packing house and textile workers.

"Fringe" cases, in WLB province, are those involving paid vacations, night shift differentials, job reclassifications, and the like, as differentiated from general wage adjustments which are limited by the Little Steel Formula.

Most of these cases involve minor changes in individual company pay rolls, but lately some have affected whole industries. The recent steel case is an example.

Until it awarded fringe demands by the steel workers resulting in an average boost of several cents an hour, the WLB had not made a single award of this kind which required a price advance to compensate management for increased costs.

9TH SON REGISTERS FOR ARMY SERVICE

LEHIGHTON, Pa., Feb. 10 (AP) — The ninth son of Mrs. Russell McFarland registered for selective service on his 18th birthday today—one day after one of his eight brothers now in the Army was reported missing in France.

Farmers Asked To Aid Fat Drive In Critical Period

Farmers can aid materially at the present time to solve a critical shortage of fats needed for war by using greater care in the salvaging of fats from home-slaughter operations, and turning in used kitchen fats to the local collector, J. Manley Scalts, Fat Salvage Committee chairman in Allen-co stated in an appeal to farmers for greater contributions to the fat salvage program.

"Right now our country needs every pound of fat we can possibly obtain," Scalts said. "It is needed for the manufacture of munitions, medicinal aids for the wounded, for war equipment, and for the machinery that manufactures the munitions and equipment. Every teaspoonful of used kitchen fats should be saved.
