LIFE SENTENCE FOR SOLDIER APPEALED

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 14 (INS)—Ernest Besig, Northern California director of the American Civil Liberties Union, said today his organization will ask the judge advocate general of the Army to set aside the conviction of Pvt. Henry Weber, who was sentenced to life imprisonment at Camp Roberts, Cal., for refusing to drill.

After conferring with the 27-year-old former Vancouver, Wash., shipyard worker who is held at Camp Roberts while Washington authorities review his case, Besig said Weber acted as his own counsel at the court-martial which heard evidence against him and was “incapable of defending himself.”

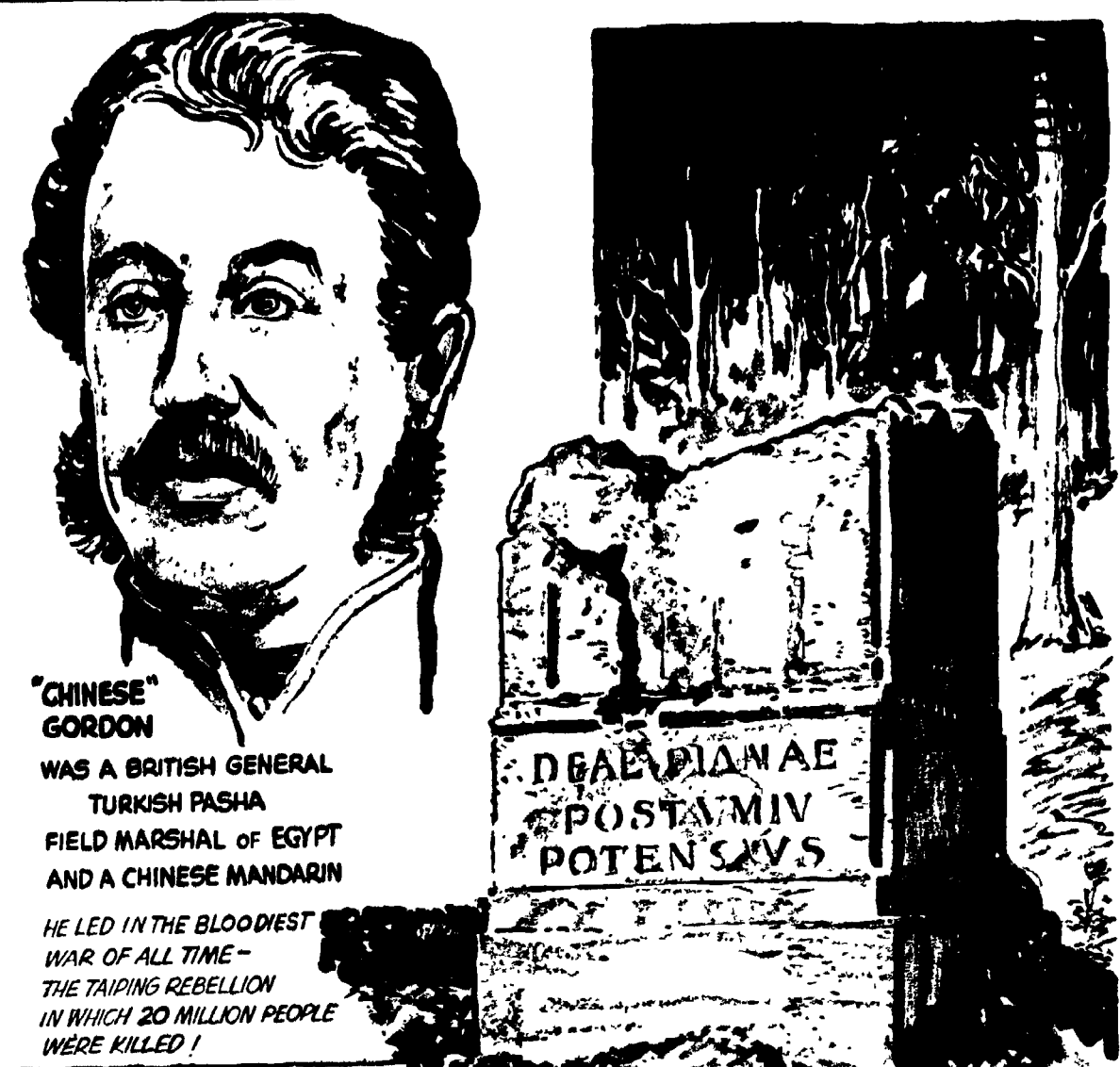
Weber originally was sentenced to hang but at the suggestion of Major Gen. Thompson Lawrence, Camp Roberts commandant, the court reconvened and commuted the sentence to life imprisonment at hard labor.
