## BASE AND DAM BUILDERS ARE HONORED BY "MOLES"

NEW YORK, Feb. 19—(UP)—The Moles, a New York organization of tunnel and heavy construction men, will give awards for outstanding contribution to construction progress to Francis T. Crowe, constructor of Boulder Dam, and William V. McMenimen, builder of Pacific construction bases. Formal presentation will be made at a dinner of 600 leading engineers and construction men in the Roosevelt hotel here Feb. 7.

McMenimen is chairman of the executive board of a group of eight contractors who have built bases at Guam, Wake, Midway, the Hawaiian Islands and other secret bases, at a total cost of a billion and a quarter dollars. In addition, they have built procurement bases at Chicago, Joliet, Fort Huene, Oakland, Akandem, Seattle and Tacoma. He has been vice president and general superintendent of the Raymond Concrete Pile Co. since 1918, and began his career as general superintendent on construction of the Hudson River tubes.

Crowe, besides building Boulder dam, has constructed such great dams as Guernsey, Deadwood River, Copper Basin, Gene Wash, Parker and Shasta. He was general superintendent of Six Companies, Inc., which completed Boulder in five years—two years and five months ahead of schedule.

### ICE CREAM BARGES

PLY SOUTH PACIFIC

WASHINGTON—(AP)—With a new type refrigerator barge the Army hopes to bring plenty of ice cream, fresh meats, fruits and vegetables to soldiers stationed on islands in the Southwest and Western Pacific.

The barge, known as the BRL (Barge, Refrigerated, Large) has a unit which turns out 10 gallons of ice cream every seven minutes and an ice plant which manufactures five tons a day.

The equivalent of 64 carloads of frozen meats can be stored in the eight main holds at 12 degrees above zero. Two main deck compartments each have a capacity of about 500 measurement tons of fresh vegetables, cheese, eggs and other perishable products.
