### FRENCH ACCUSE U. S. EXPATRIATE

PARIS Feb. 22 (UP)—Mrs. Frank L. Gould, wealthy American expatriate, was formally accused today of dealing with the Nazis.

The French Ministry of Finance, acting in concert with the United States government, ordered the justice department to investigate and to take criminal action against Mrs. Gould if necessary.

The San Francisco-born socialite is charged specifically with having wrongfully obtained 5,000,000 francs in a German-controlled bank at Monte Carlo last July 21. She said she gave the money to the Nazis to save her critically ill husband from a concentration camp.

### MAN SEES THRU ANOTHER'S EYE

CINCINNATI Feb. 22 (AP)—Forty-five-year-old Paul Markel, blind since childhood, thrilled at glimpses of the world today thru "sight" partially restored as a result of the misfortune of another.

Harry Gray, 15 of California, lost the sight of an eye Feb. 11 thru the explosion of a cartridge which he was playing. The flash damaged the optic nerve but left the cornea unharmed. That cornea, grafted into one of Markel's eyes, enabled him to see again.

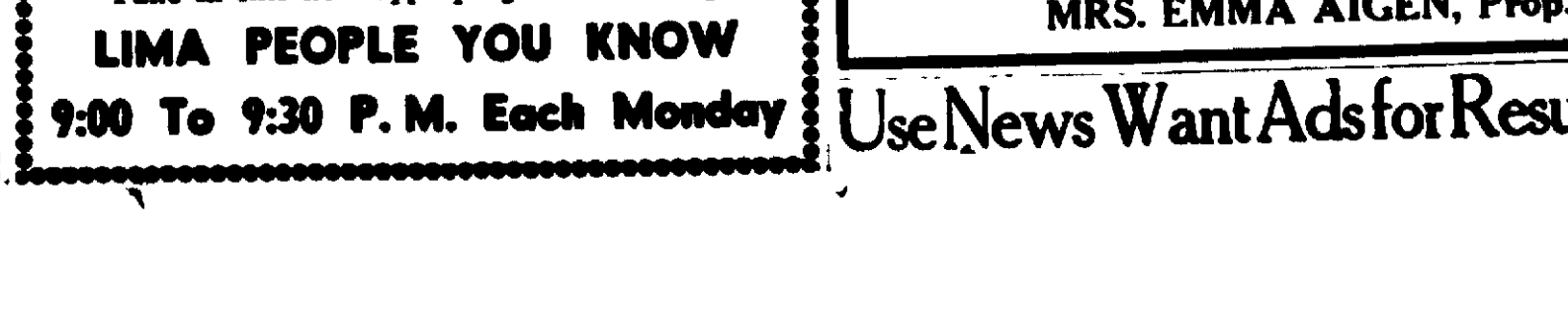
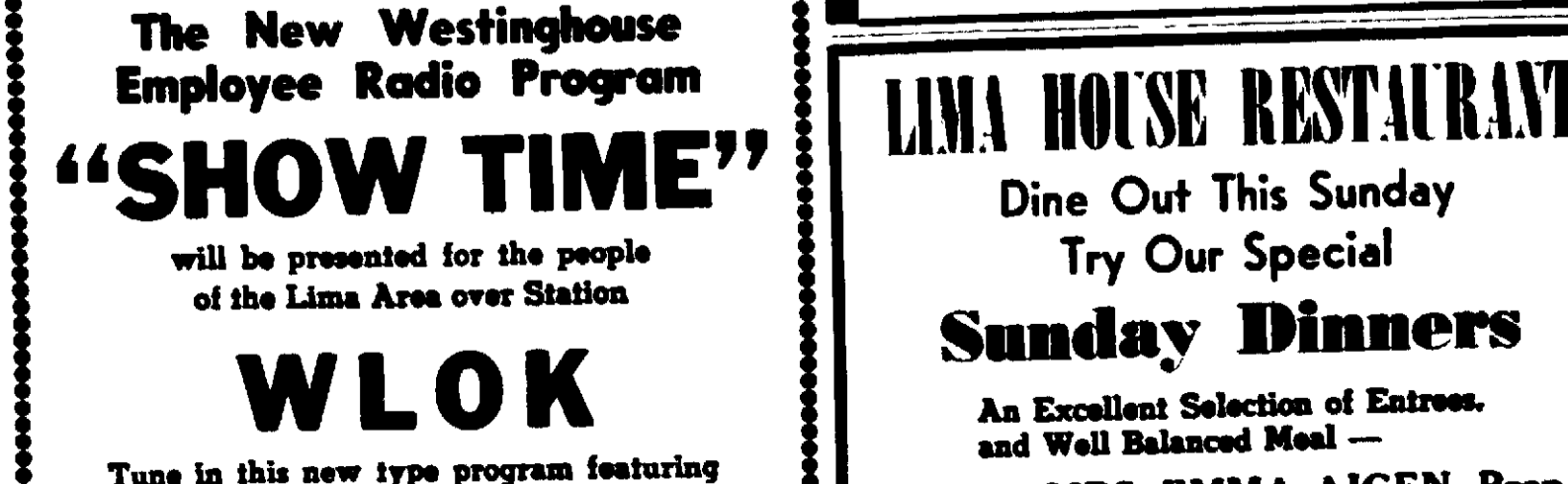
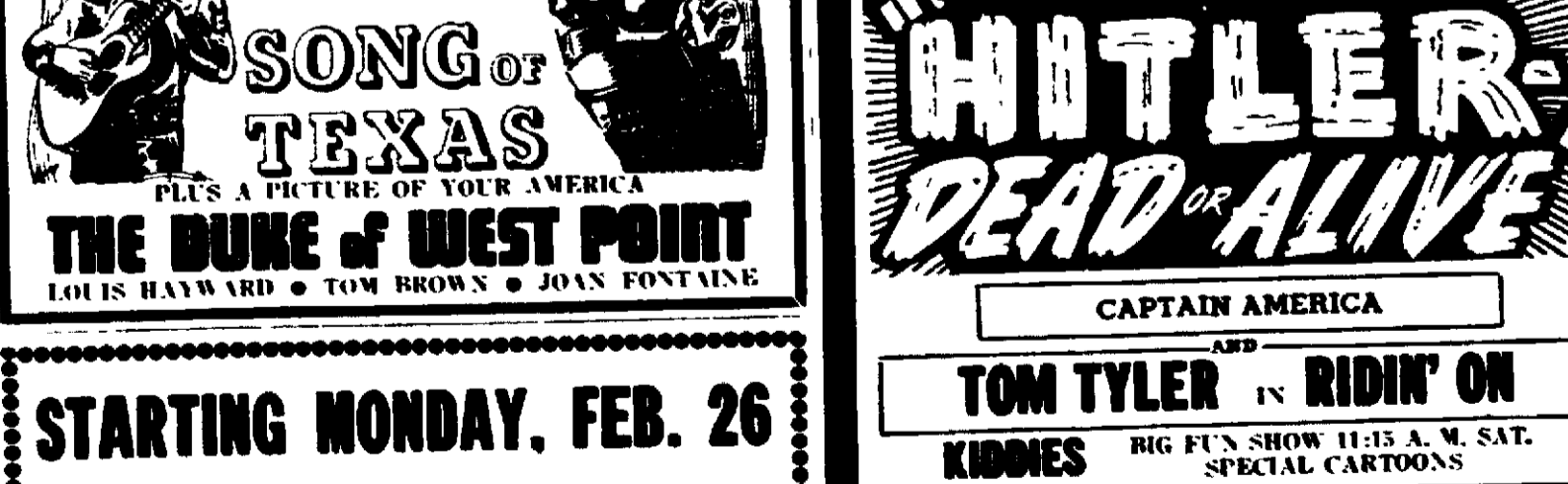
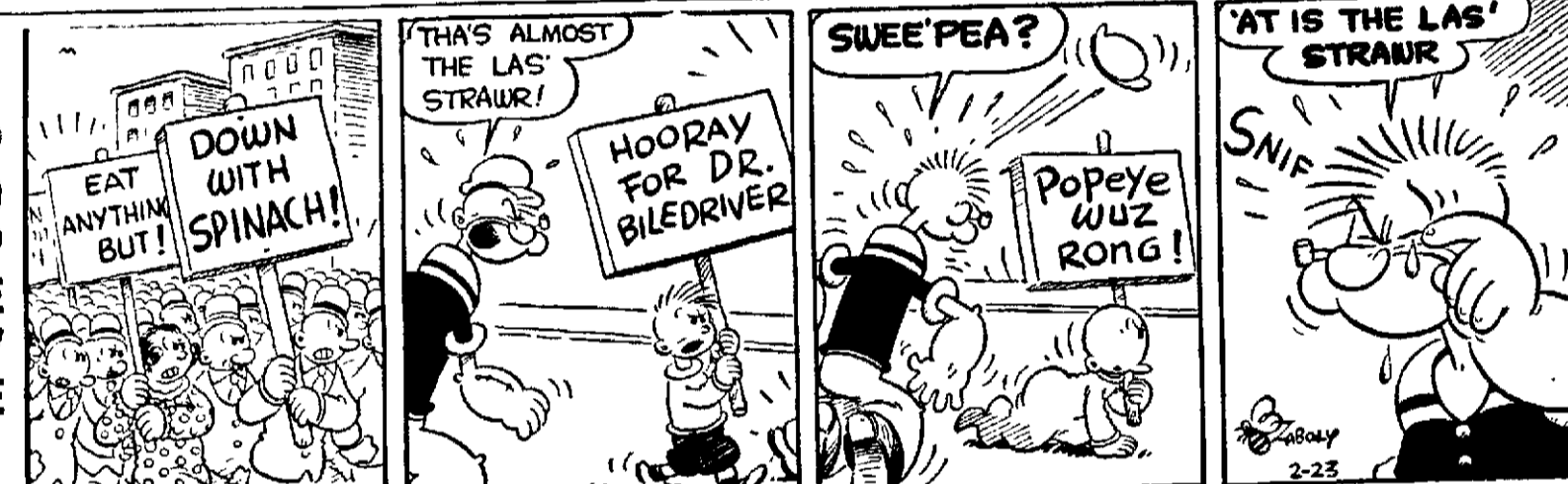
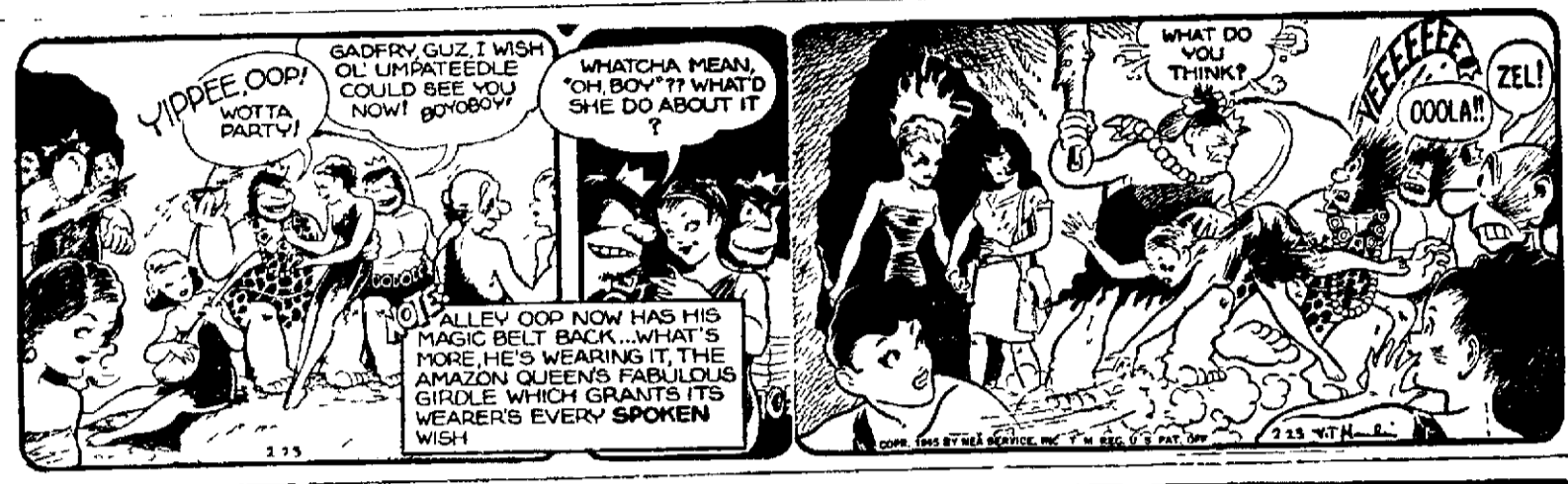
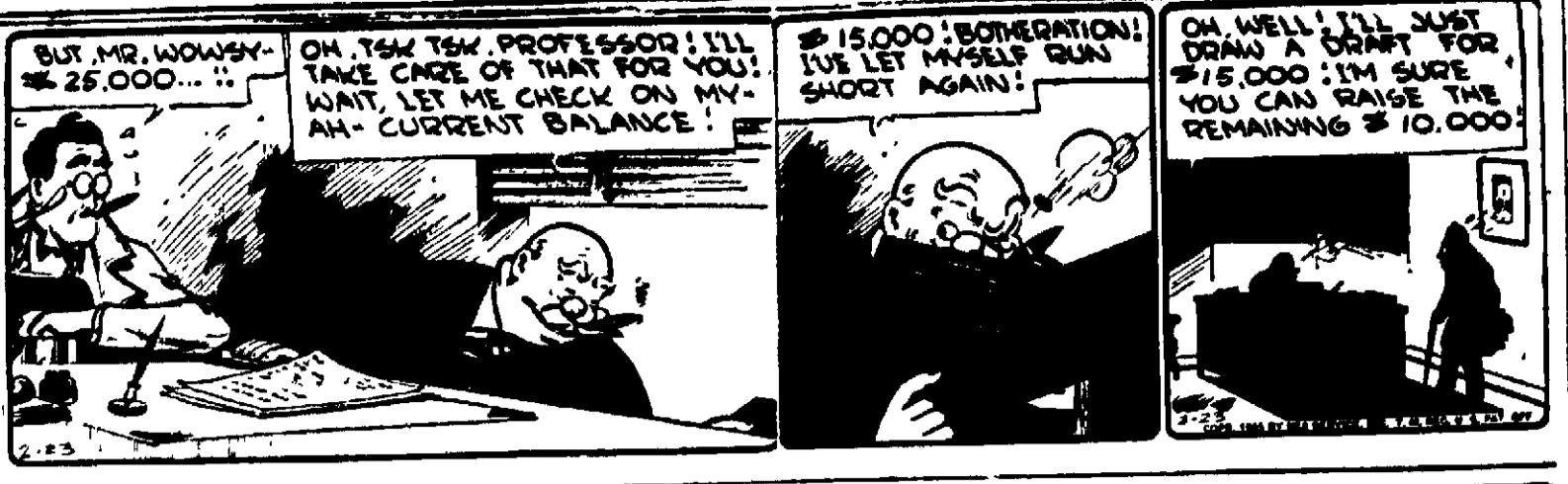
### DEWATERING PUMPS FROZEN

CHICAGO Feb. 22 (AP)—The War Production Board ordered producers to sell aside 75 per cent of their purchased, nonmilitary production of dewatering pumps as distribution in Ohio and 11 other states, where the possibility of spring floods exists, the region's WPR announced yesterday.

The order will continue thru April 1.
