FIRM MAKES MILLIONS OF "EYES OF THE WAR"

ROCHESTER, N. Y., Mar. 24—(UP)—The firm that makes the "eyes of the war"—the precision optical instruments that pinpoint enemy targets for our planes, tanks, ships and guns—hasn't forgotten the eyes of the fighting men. Bausch & Lomb Optical Co. of here makes millions of lenses for spectacles Uncle Sam provides for servicemen who wear glasses, all individually ground to the wearer's prescription. It also manufactures a special frame which fits comfortably inside a gas mask. The 60,000,000th optical part manufactured by Bausch & Lomb for the war since Pearl Harbor was unveiled recently at the 27th annual meeting of the Early Settlers, a club of 577 employees who have served the company 25 years or more. Thirty-nine of the men have been with the firm continuously for 50 years or more.

The U. S. Army Air Forces have trained more than 163,147 pilots (over 5,122 of these being glider pilots), 31,293 bombardiers and 31,906 navigators or bombardier-navigators for war service since Pearl Harbor.

Prisoners Act As Guinea Pigs

CHICAGO, Mar. 24—(UP)—Behind bars in three of the nation's federal prisons some 200 men are gambling their lives to aid the Allies on the battlefronts.

They are the "human test tubes" for medical research against malaria, one of the most dreaded enemies fighting against the Allied, as well as Japanese, armies in the Pacific, China and Burma.

They have volunteered to be bitten by the disease-carrying Anopheles mosquito so they can be inoculated with preventative drugs, still under the experimental stage of medical staffs.

Results of the experiments will remain a secret as vital as any military information the Japanese would like to obtain.

Each of the prisoners is "screened" before being accepted and doctors stress no person who

have organic ailments of the heart, liver or kidneys may be selected. Ranging from life-termers to one-year prisoners, the men are warned they may be ill from the malaria bug for a year and a half, and perhaps, longer.

Of approximately 325 volunteers at the Atlanta, Ga., federal penitentiary, only 100 prisoners were selected and at the Illinois Stateville prison, 50 men were chosen from 400 volunteers. Sixty experimentees were picked at the New Jersey reformatory at Rahway.
