# Auto Workers May Raise Dues

DETROIT, Mar. 27 — (INS)—Faced with the twin spectres of declining membership and soaring costs, the UAW-CIO may increase dues to wipe out month-by-month deficits which totalled more than a quarter million dollars in the last fiscal period.

Secretary-Treasurer George Ades in his fiscal report for the six-month period ended Nov. 30, disclosed a net deficit of \$274,688.92. Net income was \$3,348,619.02.

The deficit, which included an expenditure of \$210,000 for bonds, occurred although the international union made a \$1 assessment against its million dues paying members.

To meet this situation, Ades urged that the membership raise dues from \$1 a month to \$1.50.

He disclosed that membership declined 113,741 in the period and a gradual dropping off has occurred from the March, 1944, peak of 1,236,580 paying members.

# Lausche Urges GAR Convention

COLUMBUS, O., Mar. 26 — (AP) Gov. Frank J. Lausche today asked the Office of Defense Transportation to relax its ban on conventions and permit the national encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic to be held here next September.

"If it is consistent with the demands of war, the encampment should be allowed," the governor told his press conference, adding it would be a "great moral and patriotic inspiration to allow the Army of the Republic to assemble."

The governor said there are approximately 1,500 Civil War veterans living whose ages range from 70 to 102.

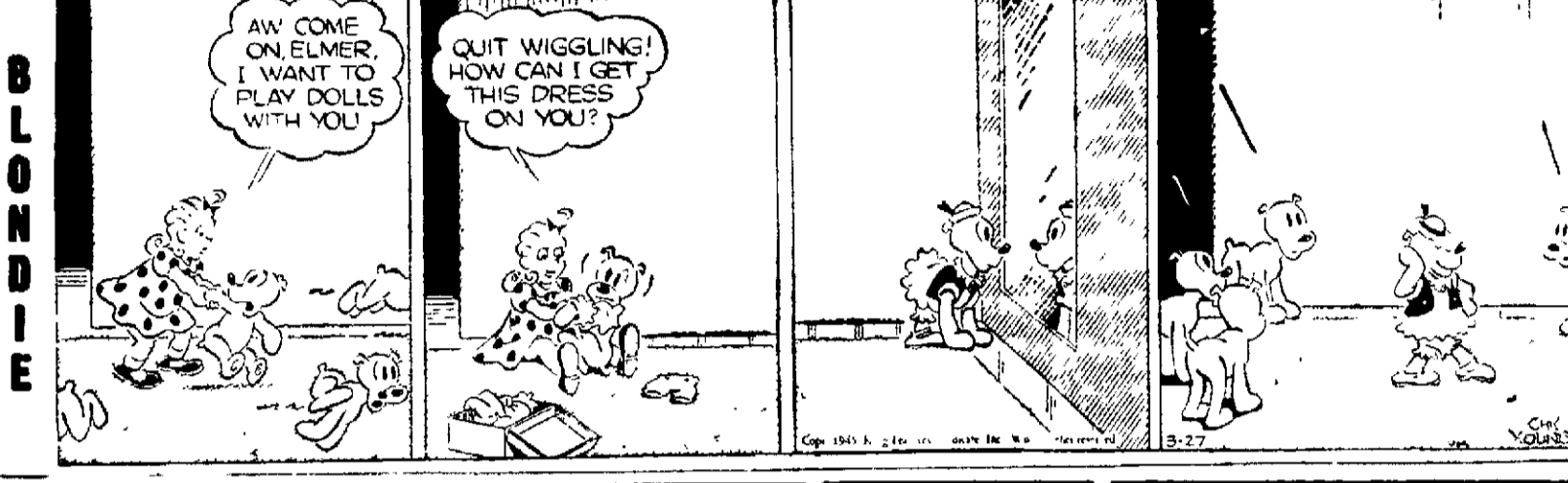
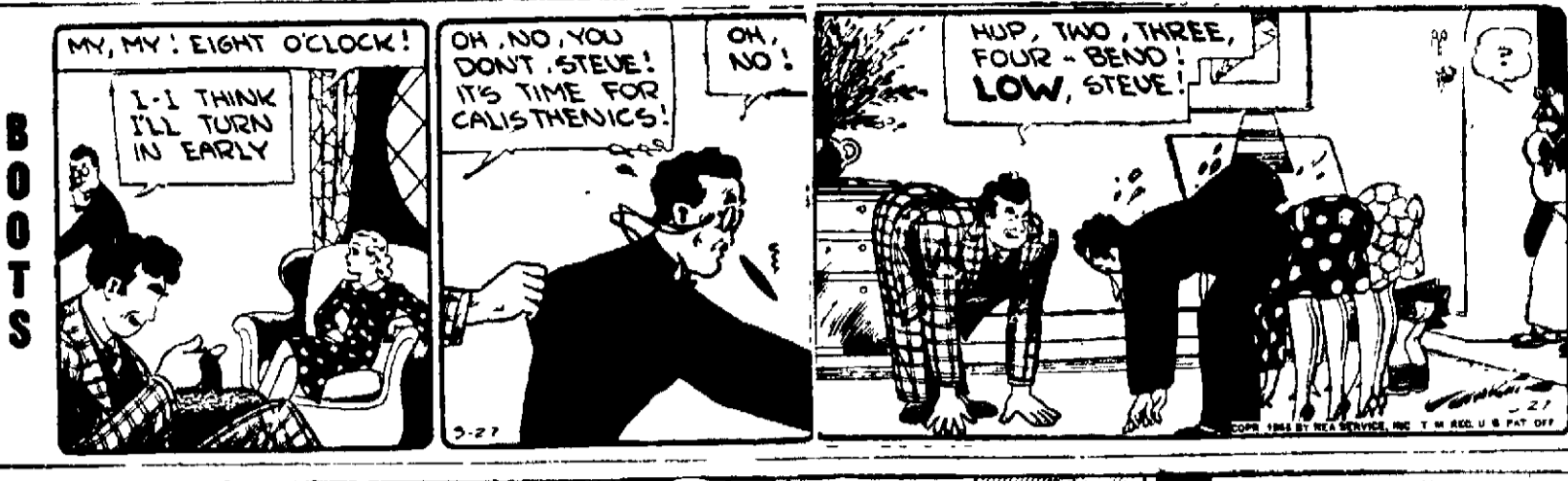
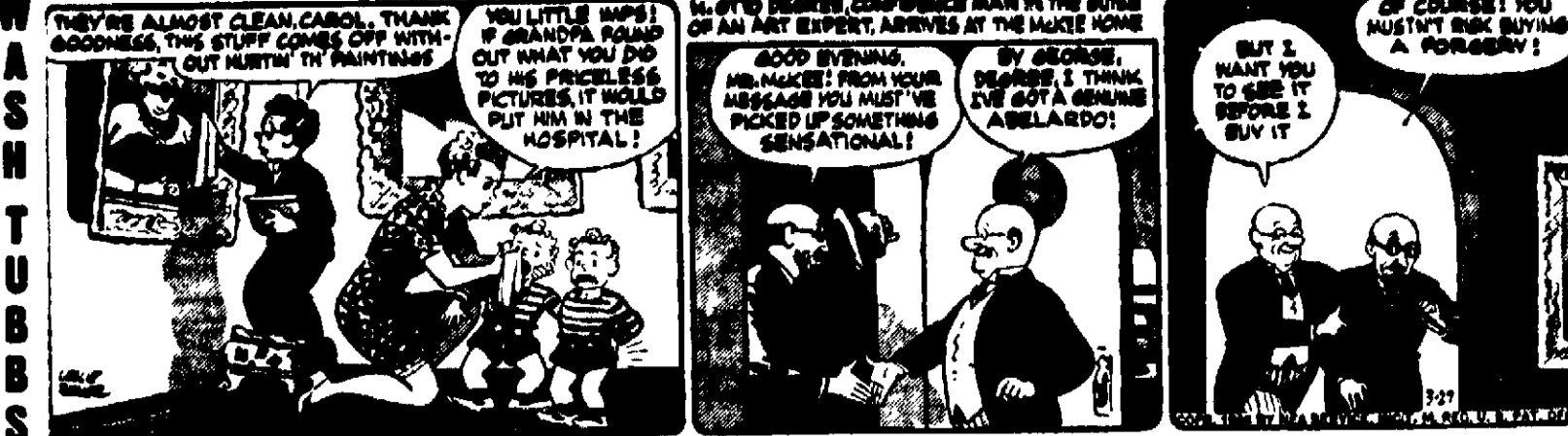

# ENGINEERS CONSTRUCT BRIDGE IN NINE HOURS

ON THE RHINE, Mar. 27 — (AP)—Twelve Ohio soldiers, members of the 202nd Engineers and the 17th Armored Engineers, helped build the world's longest trestleway pontoon bridge in nine hours.

They broke every existing bridge building record to throw the 1,146-foot structure across the Rhine south of Wesel—and they did under fire. It was finished far ahead of the bridges on the Rhine.

Among the Ohioans who helped do the job were: T-5 Buel Dayton of Franklin; Pfc. Robert Melush of Lorain; Medic Paul Scragge of Portsmouth; Cpl. Leland Dearing of Lorain; pl. Raymond Riedy of Sandusky, and Cpl. Joseph Skuba of Niles.

# Kasch Demands Pay Be Delayed

COLUMBUS, Mar. 27 — (INS)—Rep. Gus Kasch, (D-Summit) today "demanded" that State Auditor Joseph T. Ferguson withhold salaries of all but two Republican members of the house of representatives for "failing to function as a legislative body."

The two exceptions named by Kasch were Paul H. Ballard (G-Jackson) chairman of the house finance committee, and Lowell Fess (R-Green), both of whom, Kasch said, were "really trying to get something done."

Kasch told Ferguson the Republican majority in the house held a caucus and decided to do nothing in the way of enacting legislation so as to leave Democratic Gov. Frank J. Lausche "out on a limb."

Auditor Ferguson said he had no comment to make regarding Kasch's "demand."
