

# State Brings Back Colorful Musical For Return Booking

With more than 600 persons singing and dancing to twelve original tunes, "Thank Your Lucky Stars," which begins a return engagement by popular request at the State theatre Thursday is acclaimed as one of the biggest musical productions ever to come out of Hollywood.

Variety and novelty—stars doing the unexpected—characterize the majority of the sequences. Bette Davis sings and does a jitterbug routine. Errol Flynn sings and dances—in Cockney. John Garfield's routine includes singing. Ida Lupino, Olivia de Havilland and George Tobias sing and dance boogie-woogie. Ann Sheridan teaches a class in love, singing her "lecture."

## Former Sailor To Die July 14

CINCINNATI, Apr 4 — (AP) —Frank Dudley Carter, 25, Louisville, Ky., former sailor, was sentenced Tuesday to die July 14 in Ohio's electric chair for the hold-up slaying of Sgt. Anthony Overberg of Norwood police, on July 8, 1942.

Carter was convicted last Wednesday.

"I fought that man (Overberg) a fair hand to hand battle for that gun," he remarked, prior to hearing his doom. He referred to a scuffle in which he wrested Overberg's pistol from him as the latter attempted to thwart his robbery attempt.

## Ohio State Starts Memorial Drive

COLUMBUS, Apr 4 — (UP) — A scholarship fund of \$100,000 or more will serve as a permanent memorial to former Ohio State university students who lose their lives in the war, President Howard L. Bevis said today.

Contributions to the memorial now are being received thru the university's fund, he said. A gift of \$1000 or more will endow a scholarship in the name of a particular individual.

Funds will be invested and income used each year for scholarships.
