With the timeliness of this morning's calendar and the explosiveness of the latest air raid in force over enemy territory, "Hotel Berlin" epens Friday at the Ohio theatre.

"Hotel Berlin" tells the story that has been smouldering behind the Westwall for more than five years of total war. And a grim tale it is, depicting the machinations of the men and women who plan future wars in the shadow of today's dead.






