

# Lyric Has Cagey Detective, Edmund Lowe, In Current Film

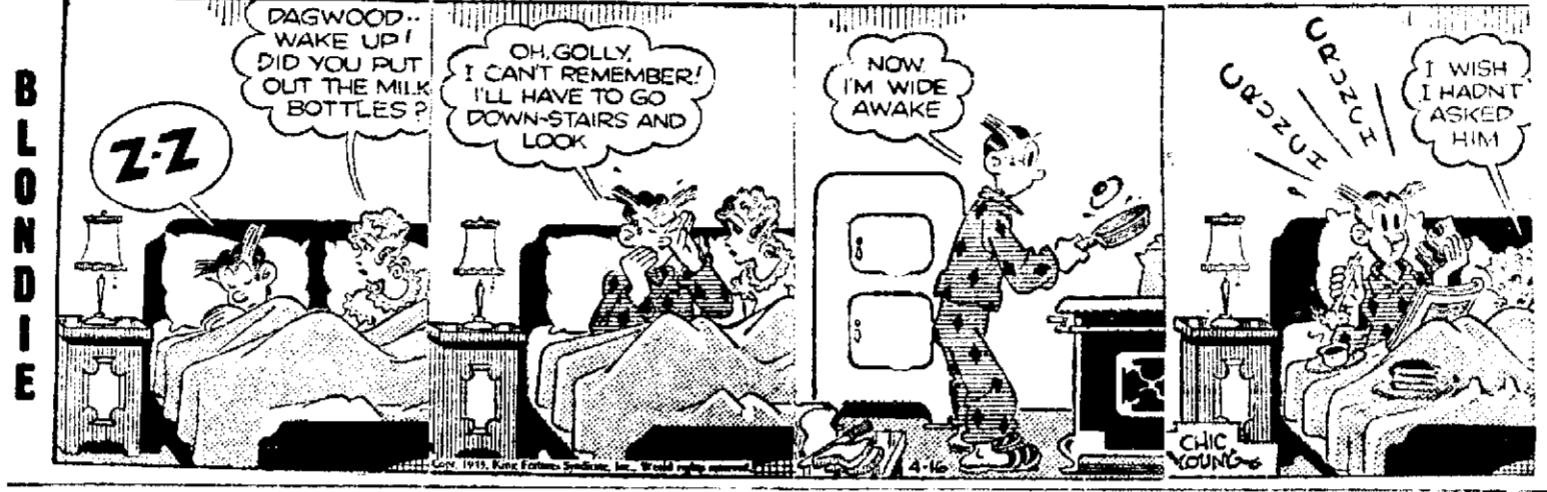
