When jewel thieves meet, then things really happen. That is a short summary of what goes on in the film, "Oh, What a Night" currently playing at the Lyric theatre.

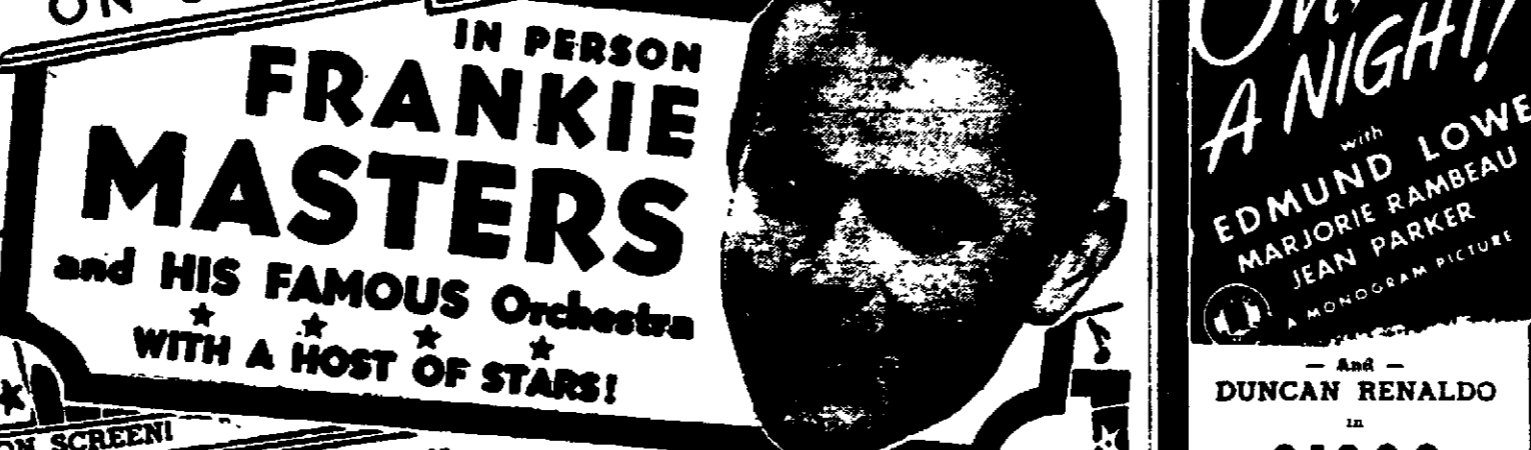
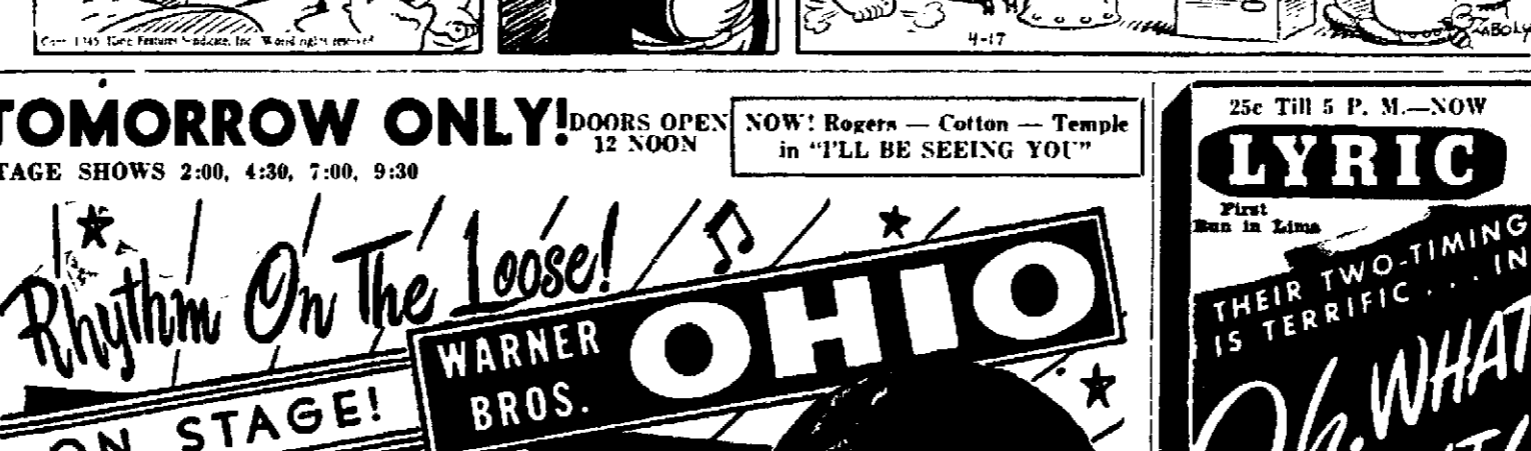
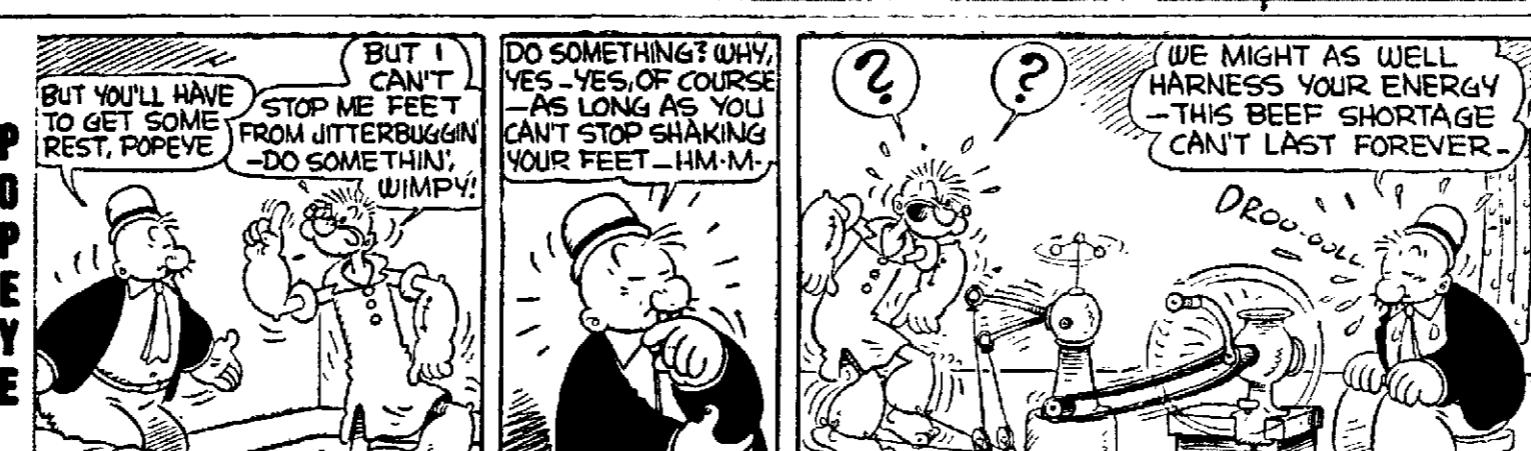
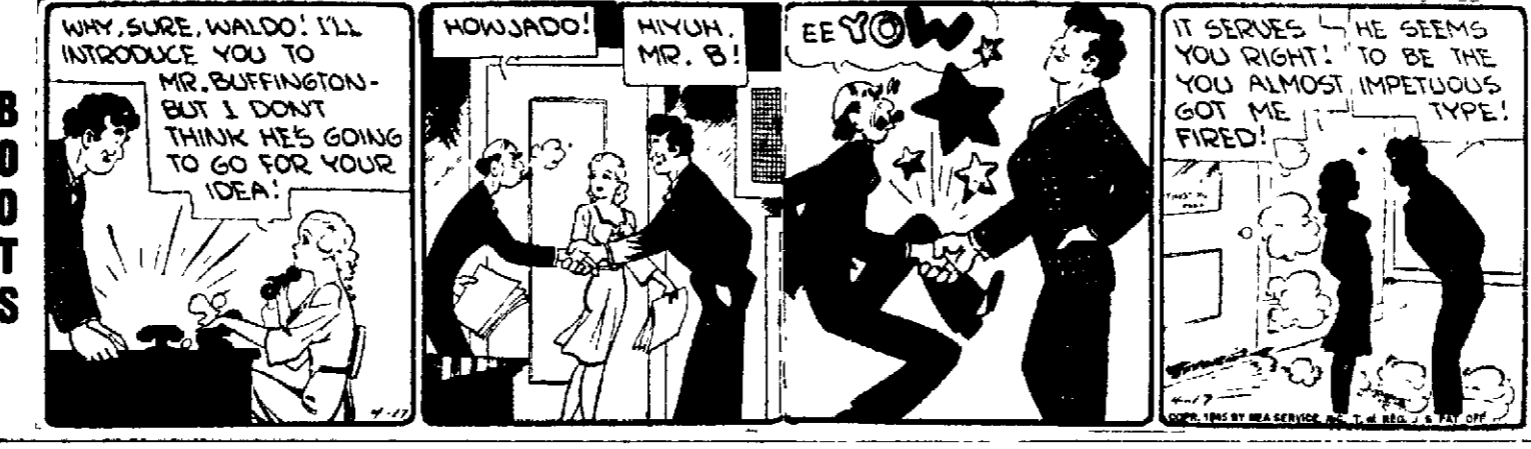
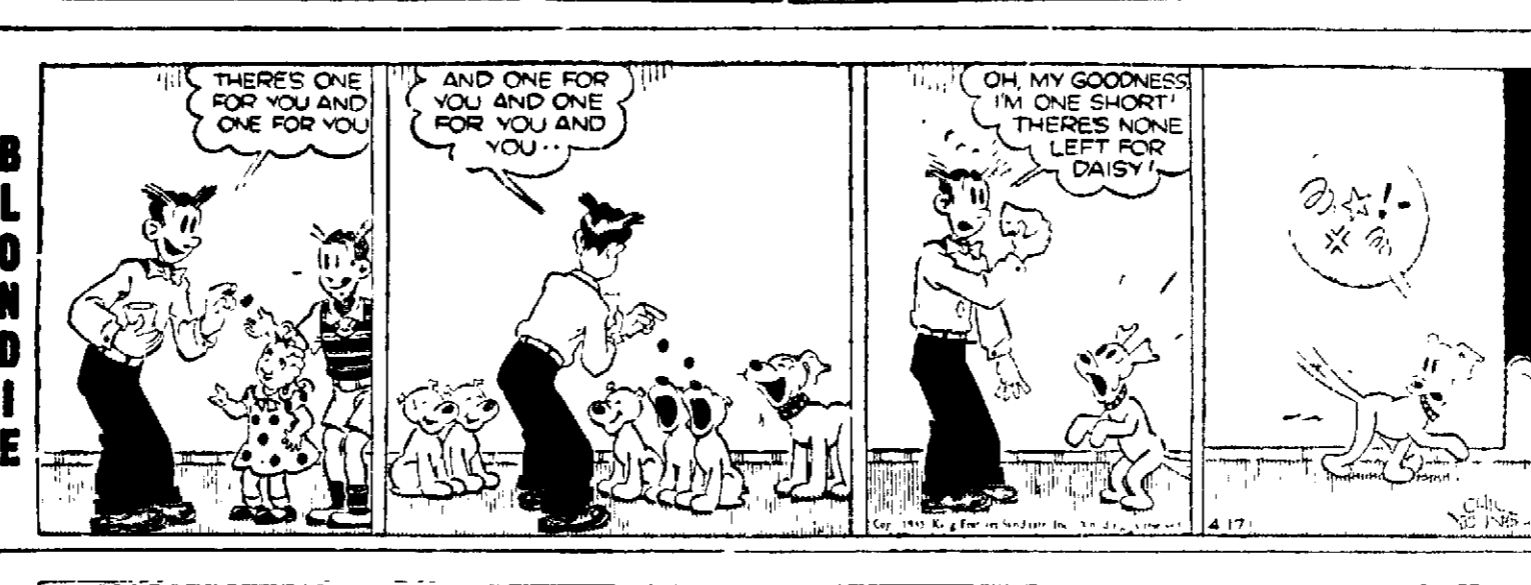
