

The insects themselves often fight one another. Dragonflies are

other insects. The dragonfly is a friend of man, since it kills mosauitoes. Among the water beetles are some which have the special name of "diving beetles." They are noted for their skill in diving, and make "submarine attacks" small fish, newts and tadpoles.


