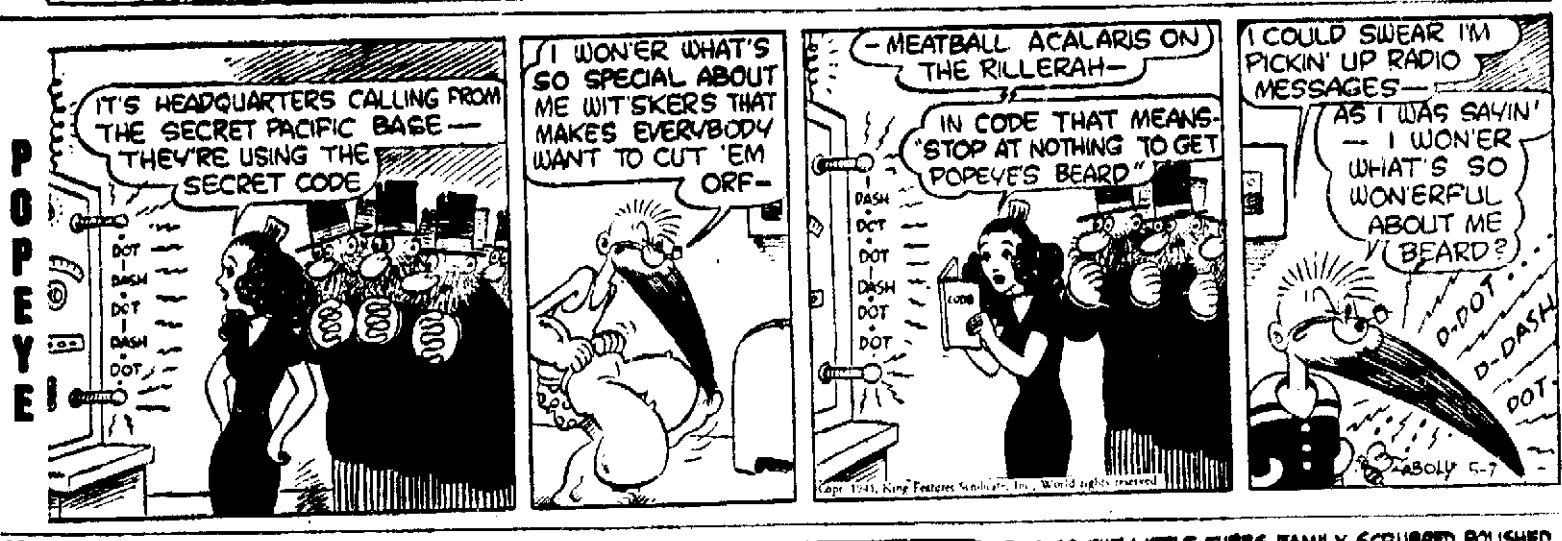
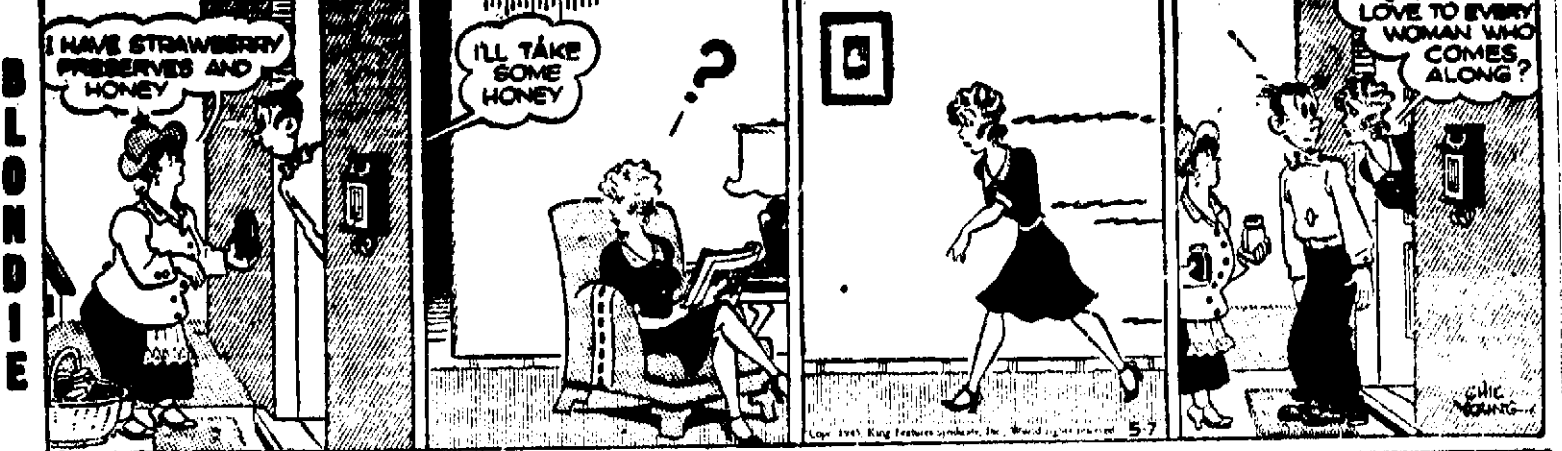

SAN FRANCISCO, May 7.—(AP)—Tokyo radio today reported directors of the Totalitarian Political-Union of Greater Japan were demanding a special session of the Japanese diet.
