## Hodgson Named To Crime Body

WASHINGTON, May 15—(AP)—President Truman today appointed Lt. Col. Joseph V. Hodgson as U. S. commissioner on the United Nations committee for investigation of war crimes.

He takes the place of Herbert Pell who resigned. He has been serving as American commissioner since Jan. 1. Prior to that he was deputy commissioner.

Hodgson, 46, is a native of Boyne Falls, Mich. He was attorney general of Hawaii until 1942 when he entered army service as a major.

He came to Washington in 1943 and entered the judge advocate general's office, then went to the European theatre of operations in May, 1944. He now is assigned to a judge advocate general's office in the European theatre.

### Veterans Protest Coddling Goering

WASHINGTON, May 15—(AP)—The Veterans of Foreign Wars today protested what they called "coddling" by American military authorities of Nazi Air Marshal Goering.

In a broadcast talk, Omar B. Ketchum, the VFW's national legislative representative, said Goering, "instead of being immediately tossed in the clink with a grim warning that anything he said would be used against him by the War Crimes Commission, he was, according to press reports, received as a dignitary."

He added: "Shades of Belsen, Buchenwald and Dachau and the pitiful half ghosts of the living dead, inhaled in those concentration camps.

### Gunmen Sought In Revenge Slaying

JERSEY CITY, N. J., May 15—(INS)—Three gunmen were sought today by police in connection with the revenge murder of Joseph (Gunboat) Mastropole, 33, small-time gambler, half of whose body was found wrapped in a tablecloth floating in the Hudson river near Edgewater.

The slayers, police believe, killed Mastropole last May 2 after he threatened to report their identities to police unless they returned approximately \$3,000 to him which they took in a \$10,000 stickup of a Passaic club.

### Tokyo Denies Bids For Peace

(By The United Press)

Tokyo radio claimed today that any Allied interpretation of Japan's continuation of friendly relations with Russia as constituting a bid for peace was "an entirely mistaken idea."

"Japan has clearly stated to the world that she will fight to the end against Britain and America and at the same time maintain friendly relations with Soviet Russia," said a broadcast, recorded by the FCC.

Tokyo conceded, however, that the end of the war in Europe would make Japan's "future tremendously difficult."
