

foremost of the CANARY ISLANDS. Tall mountains rise on the Canaries, and these provide the shores with steep cliffs. The mountains are cut by deep valleys, and in the valleys grow many binds of plants. kinds of plants.

Far to the eastern side of the islands is one which has a gummy juice with a deep red color. The juice made early Spanish settlers think of old stories about dragons,

A cut in the tree trunk will cause the red juice to come forth, It also appears on leaves without any cut being made.

 Dragon trees do not grow very tall, but their trunks get to be thicker and thicker as the years go by.

Most trees have rings which make it possible to tell how old they are. Dragon trees, however,

do not have rings. Without rings to count, we can-not tell the exact age of a tree. Yet studies have been made to learn the rate at which dragon trees add to the thickness of their trunks.

The biggest dragon tree on rec-

ord was blown down in a heavy windstorm 77 years ago. It was about 75 feet tall, and its trunk was close to 18 feet thick. Based on the studies of dragon tree growth, it has been estimated that the huge dragon tree was at least 5,000 years old when it at


