Lady Bountiful Dies In Denver Fight For Nurse Draft Is Dropped

DENVER, May 29 — (AP) — Mrs. Verner Z. Reed, 70, former Ohioan who became Colorado's "lady bountiful," died yesterday after a long illness.

A native of Bucyrus, Ohio, Mrs. Reed inherited the oil and gold mining fortune of her husband and became one of Colorado's best-known philanthropists.

She reopened one of her mines at Cripple Creek to provide work for unemployed during the depression, established a \$1,000,000 fund for charity, gave a library building to the University of Denver and a girls' dormitory to the University of Colorado, and furnished large sums to other institutions.

The Army abandoned its fight for a nurse draft law today, conceding that the end of German resistance and increased recruitment of nurses had eliminated the need.

Ask Lifting Of Price Ceilings

COLUMBUS, O., May 29—(AP)—The immediate removal of price ceilings on perishable fruits and vegetables was recommended at a fruit and vegetable conference of the Ohio Department of Agriculture. Director John M. Hodson announced today.

Representatives of producers and distributors of fruits, met yesterday with the Ohio Farm Bureau, the Ohio State Grange, Ohio State university's college of agriculture, the Office of Price Administration and the War Food Administration to discuss conditions in the marketing of fruits and vegetables under price regulations.

The meeting in a resolution said the removal "would stimulate production, would not contribute to inflation, and would be in the public interest."

They recommended that "price controls be continued on a fair and workable basis for many commodities including manufactured goods and many agricultural commodities including staple fruits and vegetables."

Of approximately 4,400 children of pre-school age who died in 1942, an estimated 2,500 met their death in the home.
