CHINESE FISHERMEN on their "CATAMARAN" Today there are several forms of catamaran, but at the start this craft was made from three trunks, or logs, which were tied together. For many years, natives of the Madras district in southern India have used catamarans to go to vessels anchored some distance from shore. The Madras catamaran is composed of three long timbers lashed together so the middle one is low enough to serve as a keel. A man paddling this type of catamaran can ride the surf better than if he used a small boat of common design. Other forms of catamaran are used off the coasts of China and New Guinea. The Chinese fasten bamboo poles together, and put up a tall sail. This raft-with-a-sail is called a "tek-pai" by the Chinese, and it has proved very seaworthy. New Guinea catamarans are made with three or more logs which are held in place with rattan. Down in South America we find rafts of the catamaran type. They are made of many logs or timbers which are fastened together. One of them may be as much as 20 feet wide and 70 feet long. Fitted with large sails, these rafts travel over ocean water near the coast of Peru. Often classed as a catamaran is the two-hulled "proa." The proa has been used in both the Indian ocean and the Pacific for a long time. It is noted for its sailing speed, and for this reason has the special name of "flying proa."
