



When we speak of a forest, we are apt to think of many trees and sirrubs together. A "bamboo forest," however, is without trees. The bamboo is classed as a tall grass, not as a tree.

The height which a bamboo plant will reach depends on which kind it is. Some bamboos grow to be only four or five feet tall. Oth-

ers may have a height of from 25 to 40 feet. Still others may get to be from 100 to 120 feet tail.

In the same way the stems of bamboos differ in thickness. Some, like those for fishpoles, are only about an inch thick. Other bamboo stems are from 10 to 16 inches thick!
