Seek Oriental Sugar Quickly

WASHINGTON, June 2—(AP)—Civilian food experts soon may be moving in the wake of battle in the Pacific to speed the return to crop production, particularly world scarce sugar.

Rep. Anderson (D-NM), confirmed yesterday as secretary of agriculture, recommended to President Truman during a White House conference that food men be sent into Pacific invasions with the army to hasten soil rehabilitation when the shooting stops.

"All the Pacific islands clear to the China coast are potential sugar producers, and we're not getting it," Anderson told a reporter after the conference.

The revived production in the islands could go to the army and navy there, lightening the drain on civilian sugar supplies in this country.
