WASHINGTON, June 5—(INS)—Sale of "E" bonds in the Seventh War Loan drive climbed to 47 per cent of the goal of four billion dollars as the drive entered its final month.

Ted R. Gamble, national director of the Treasury department's war finance division, in announcing the figure, said that individual sales have reached \$3,385,000,000, or 48.5 per cent of their goal.
