

Hollywood Sends Lima Varied Picture Fare

Romance And Manhunt Key Film Plots

Across the country from the west coast town of Hollywood there have come movies of many different kinds. Lima, this Sunday, is receiving only a sample of what's to come in the future.

The regeneration of two persons embittered by the world's treatment of them is brilliantly told in "The Enchanted Cottage," new dramatic romance at the Ohio theatre. Dorothy McGuire, Robert Young and Herbert Marshall have the starring roles in the film, which has most of its action in and around an isolated cottage on the New England coast.

The wild criminal career of John Dillinger, who was the object of the most intense manhunt in the history of the United States a few years ago, is followed in intimate detail in "Dillinger," the exciting new drama now at the Quilna theatre. Lawrence Tierney plays in the title role, and the cast also includes many such popular screen players as Edmund Lowe, Anne Jeffreys, Elisha Cook, Jr., Ralph Lewis, Eduardo Canneli and Marc Lawrence.

You can't discourage those Hollywood movie people when they go out on a colorful location to make a movie in Indian country. For instance, for a scene of "Sudan" now showing at the Sigma theatre, a lake into which Maria Montez was to be dunked, dried up but, undaunted, the construction crew brought in pumps and filled it again. Miss Montez got her dunking after all.

Depicting the heroic men who helped fight off the Japs long before the United States entered this global war, "God Is My Co-Pilot" opens Sunday at the State theatre. The film has such screen favorites as Dennis Morgan, Andrea King, Dana Clark, Raymond Massey and Alan Hale in the title roles.

Ann Corio, long known to fame as "the loveliest lady of burlesque," has definitely turned her back on her first love. By way of the legitimate stage, she has finally become one of the eye-filling attractions of the motion picture screen. Miss Corio comes to the Lyric theatre Monday as the star of "Call of the Jungle," a drama which details exciting events on an isolated island of the South Seas.
