Then he noticed it was from a German war prisoner camp in Nebraska. It had been written by his brother, Eric, who is a prisoner there. Brautigan immediately arranged to visit the camp in an effort to learn the whereabouts of his parents whom he hasn't heard from since before the war. Brautigan, who came to the United States from Germany 21 years ago, is employed in a local plant which has been turning out weapons for the defeat of Germany.

Enemy Assets Will Be Seized

WASHINGTON, June 11—(INS)—President Truman authorized the Alien Property Custodian today to seize German and Japanese cash assets in the United States. The assets belonging to residents of Germany and Japan amount to about \$22,000,000. They have been held during the war by the treasury's foreign funds control division. Under the executive order issued by President Truman, these assets, which have been "frozen" in the names of owners, will revert to the United States.

Escapee Killed In Pacific Area

LONDON, O., June 11—(AP)—Superintendent W. F. Amrine of the London prison farm reports today that the Federal Bureau of Investigation has verified that James Gallagher, who escaped from the Lebanon honor farm on Apr. 6, 1934, has been killed in action while serving with the armed forces in the Pacific area. Amrine said it was the first case of an escapee from the institution being reported a war casualty. He said Gallagher, a native of Ireland, was killed May 15, 1943. He had entered the Army under the name of James Joseph Donahue.
