# Seven Executed For Espionage

MANILA, June 14—(INS)—Execution of several Japs and Filipinos for espionage activities against our forces in the Philippines was disclosed today by Gen Douglas MacArthur.

Six Japs and one Filipino were executed at Sixth Army headquarters on Luzon after being convicted of spying by a military commission. In addition, two Jap privates were hanged the morning of June 6, and an hour later, two Jap civilians also were hanged.

On the morning of the seventh, the remainder of the Japs and a Filipino attached to the enemy force, were executed.

It was the largest group of persons to be executed on spying charges in that theatre.
