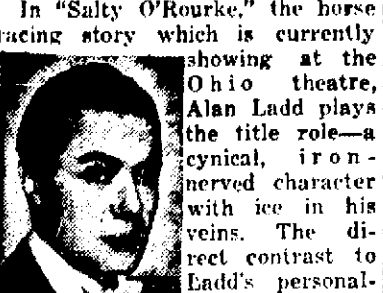


Widow Lives For The Past... Then She Meets Mr. Boyer

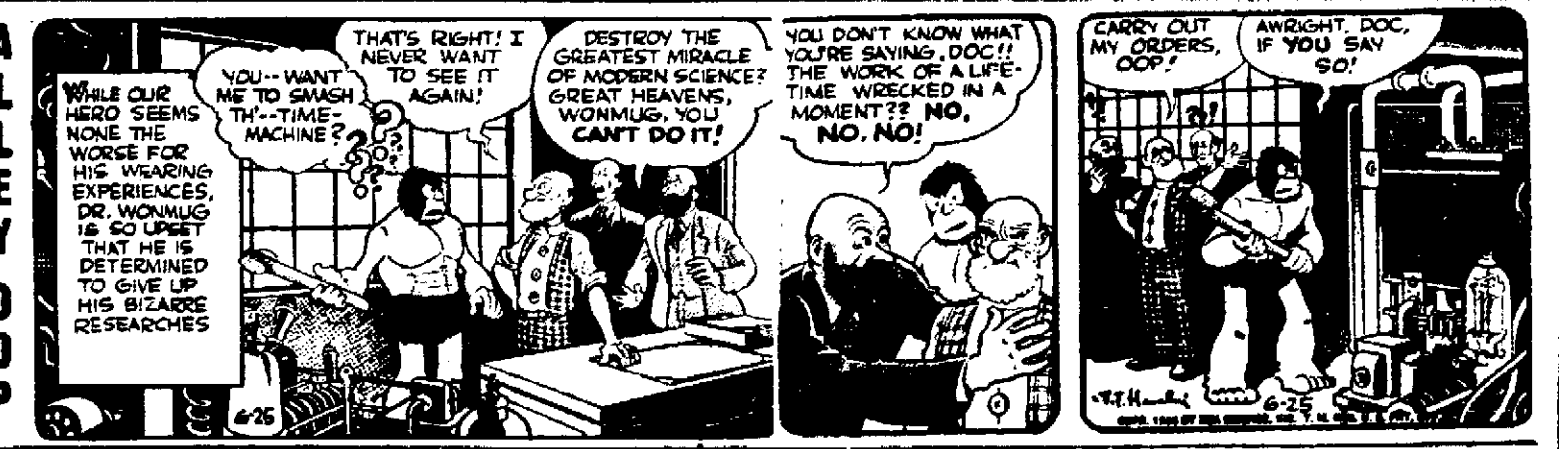
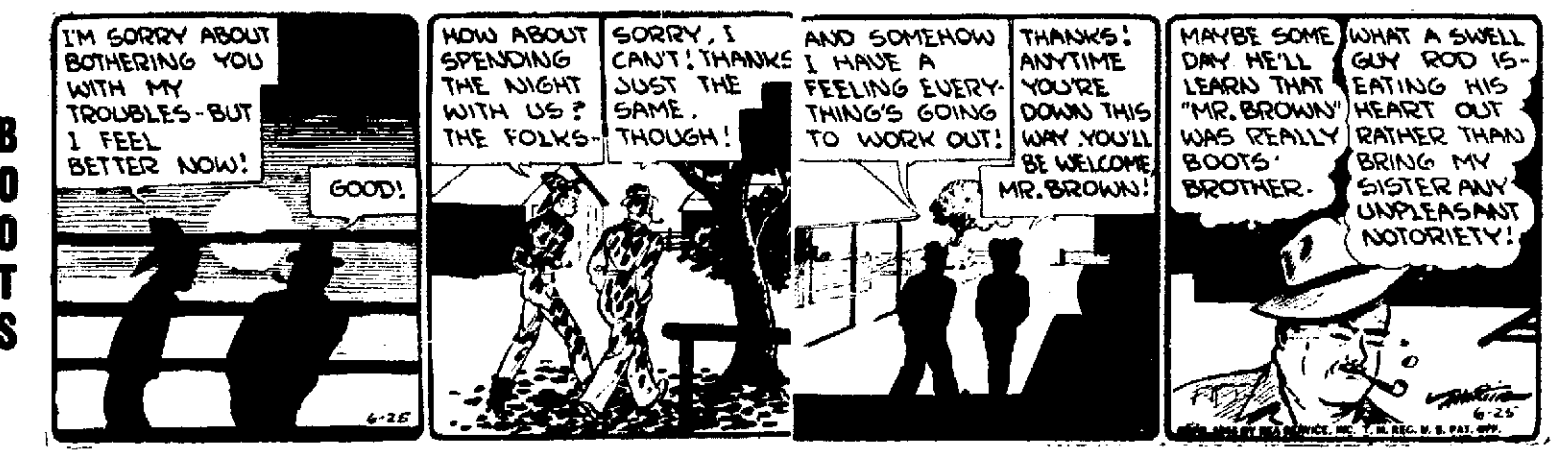
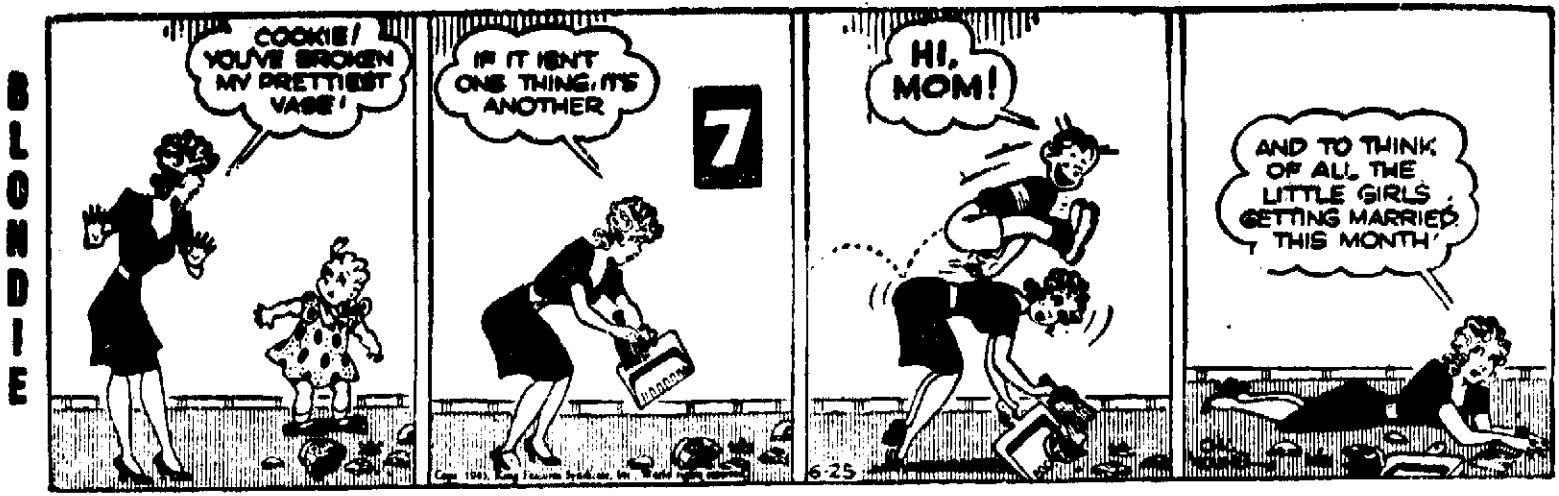

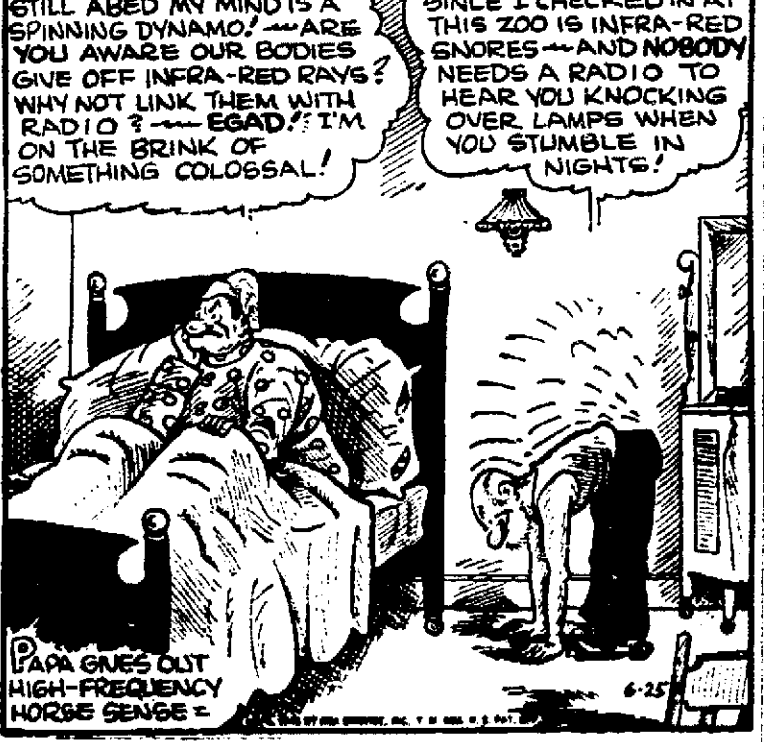
MAN KILLED IN FALL

'Woman In The Window' Aired With Originals Taking Leads

The original screen stars, Edward G. Robinson and Joan Bennett, will recreate their roles for the full-hour program. Lux Radio Theatre returns to the airwaves Monday, Aug. 27.

"Calling Radio Tokyo," a new Army Service Forces musical series, premieres over Station WJZ Monday at 10 p. m. She's set to accompany a winning service man to a top Hollywood night spot for a free evening of fun.
