WASHINGTON, July 20 (AP)—The senate military affairs committee approved today a resolution urging the release of 30,000 men from the Army to work in bituminous coal mines.

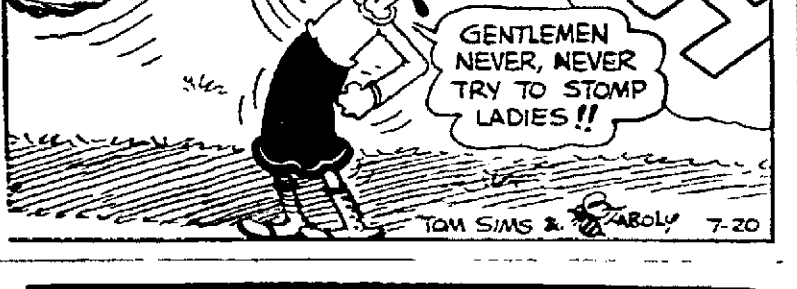
Senator Revercomb (R-W. Va.) said he hoped the resolution may be considered today by the senate.

The resolution asks the War department to expedite the release of 10,000 soldiers with mining experience points for discharge, and in addition to furlough 20,000 in the continental United States to work in the mines.

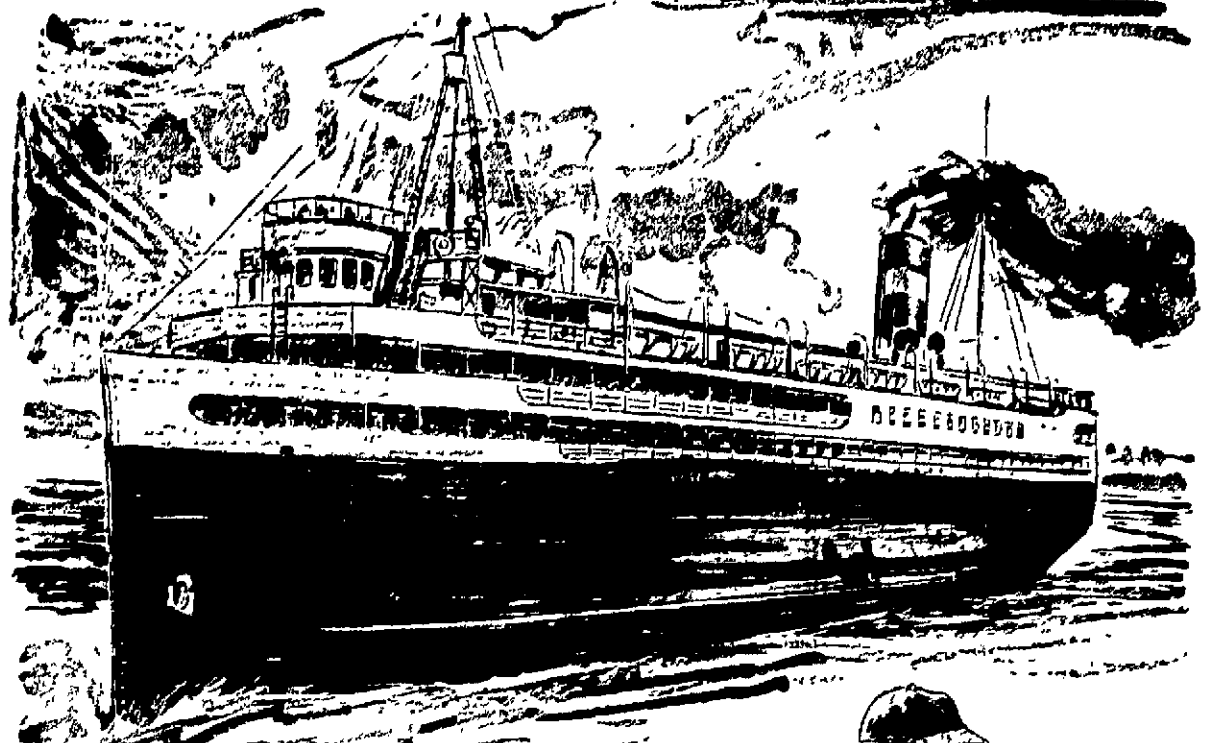

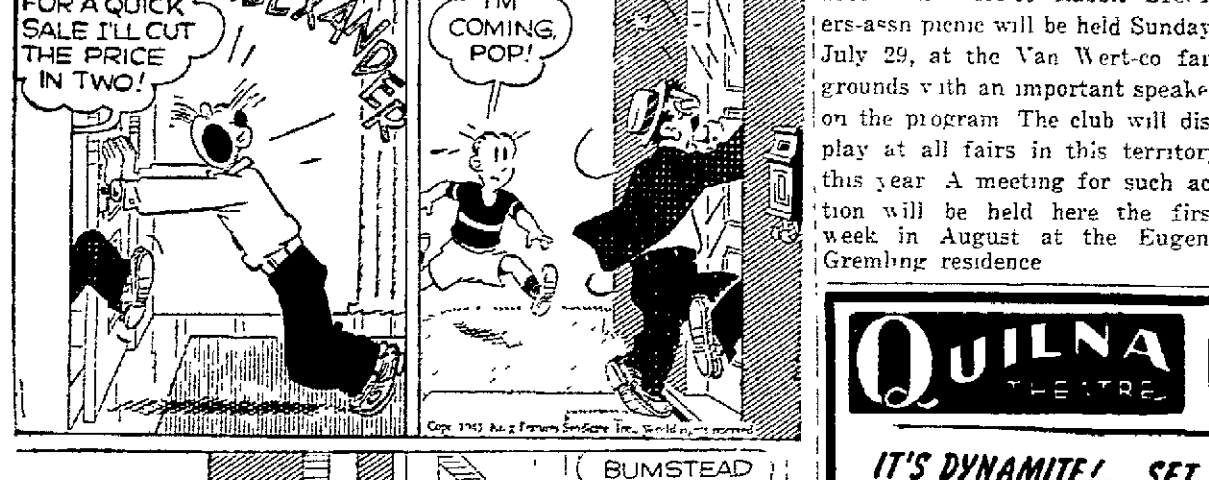
