## Rationing Of Stoves To End

WASHINGTON, July 20 (AP) — Rationing of gas cooking and gas heating stoves will end July 31.

Oil cooking, oil heating, combination oil-gas stoves and oil conversion burners for stoves will remain under rationing.

Announcing this today, the War Production Board and the Office of Price Administration said a substantial increase in production of gas heating and cooking stoves is scheduled for the current quarter, making rationing no longer necessary.

Oil burning stoves are being retained under rationing because of the short supply of fuel oil and kerosene.

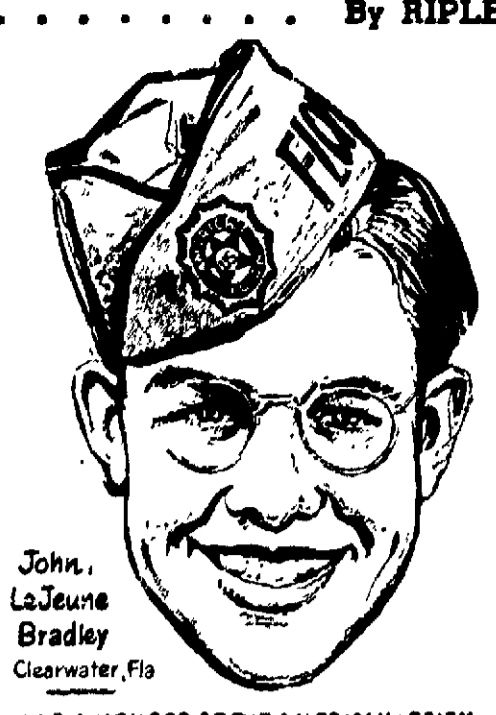

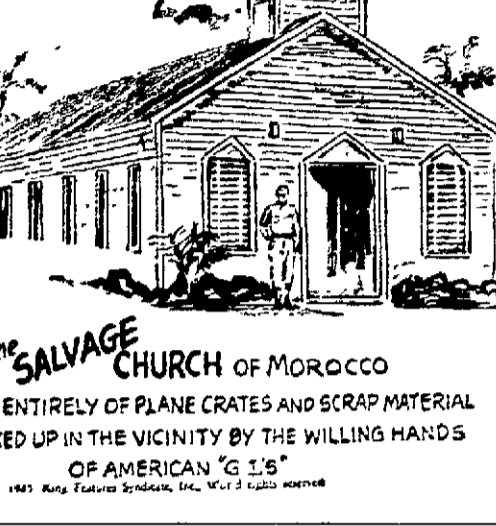

## Man Hopes He Is Forgiven By Sweetheart

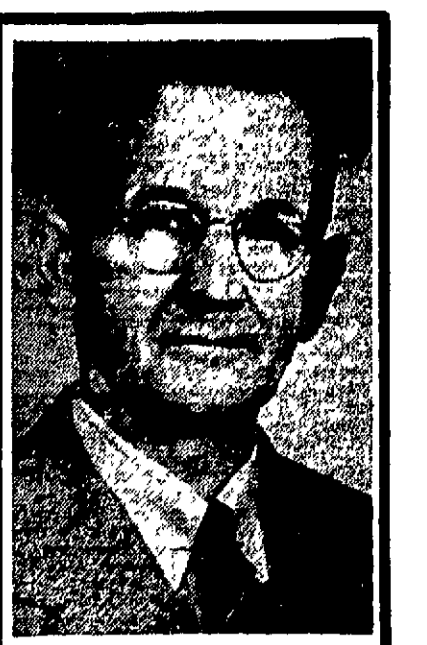
