Miner Release Plan Delayed

WASHINGTON, July 21—(AP)—Senate consideration of a resolution for the Army to release 30,000 experienced coal miners is at a standstill following objections by Sen. Chan Gurney (R-SD) that the selective service act provided no special deferment for any class of workers.

Sen. Bevercomb (R-W Va), seeking unanimous consent of the measure, said the resolution asked immediate discharge from the Army of 10,000 miners who have sufficient points for a discharge, and furlough of 20,000 other experienced miners.
