Nazi Toll Is Near Two Million Mark

BERLIN, July 31—(AP)—The Nazis' unsuccessful bid for world domination cost the German army, navy and air force nearly two million dead from the start of the war until Nov. 30, 1944, according to figures from German documents.

The documents were seized from the Berlin home of Gen. Hermann Reineke, described as propaganda chief for the German army, and listed 1,911,300 as killed or fatally wounded in the three services, including 1,419,000 on the Russian front.

CROP INSPECTORS NAMED

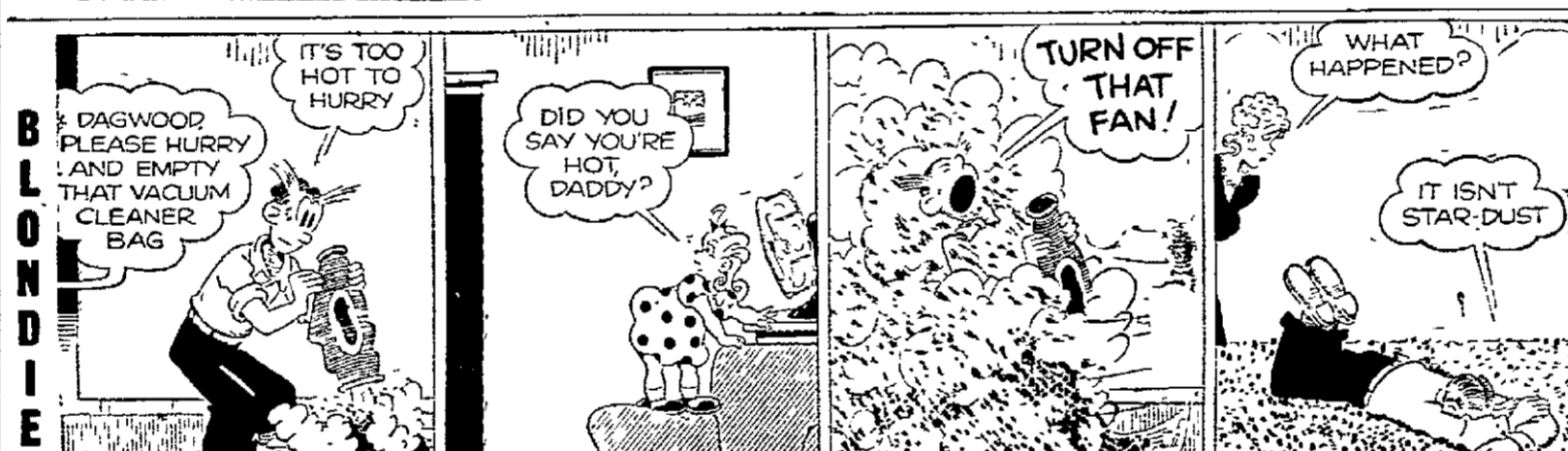
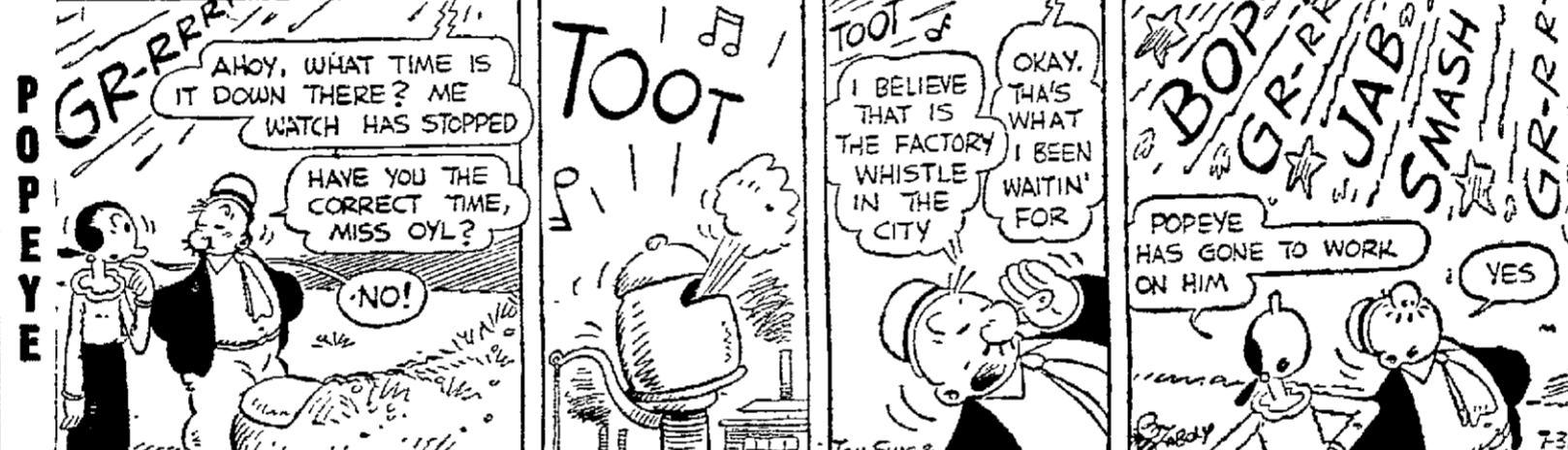
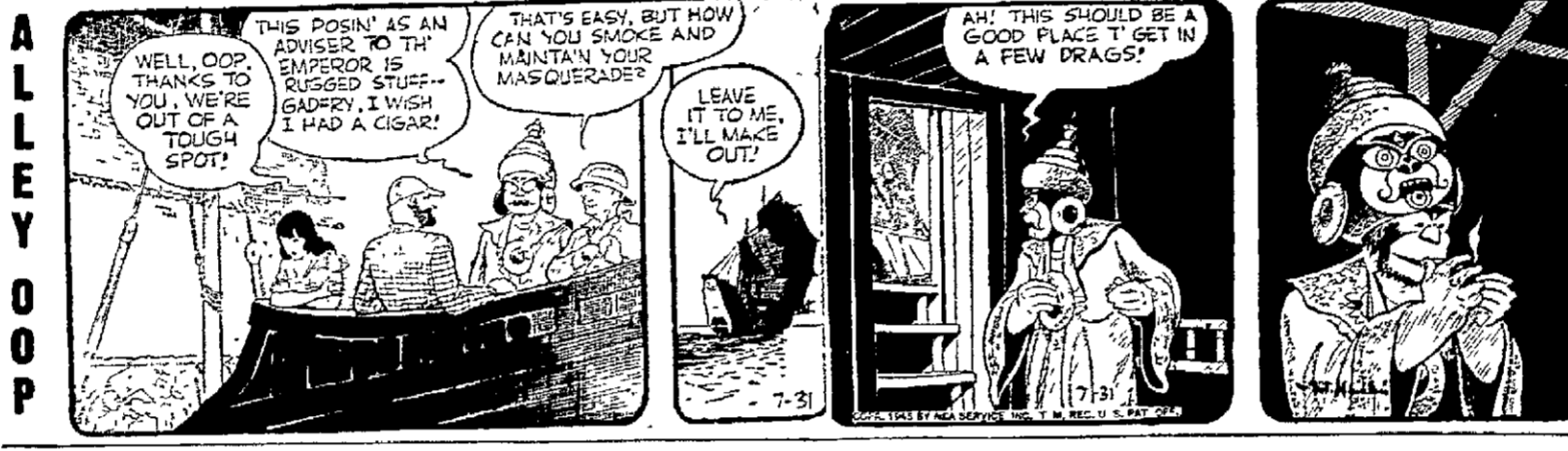
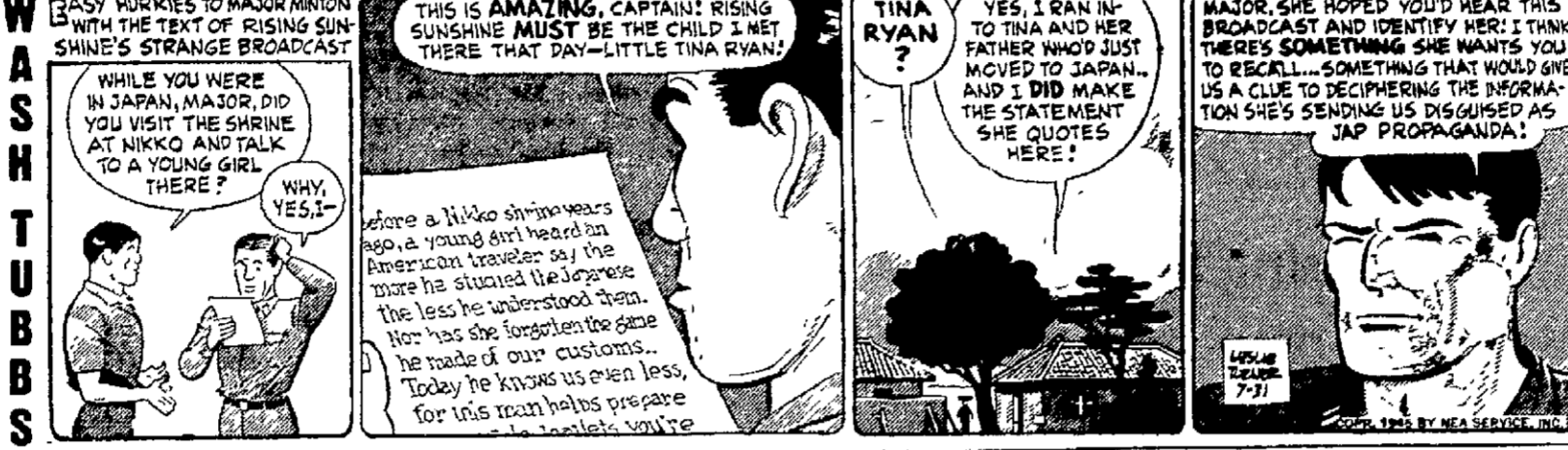
