

Mystery, Drama Of Old Peru In "Bridge Of San Luis Rey"

Out of the color, mystery and drama of old Peru, which provide dramatic highlights for Thornton Wilder's Pulitzer Prize-winning novel, has been created the entertainment-packed film, "Bridge of San Luis Rey," opening Monday at the Lyric theatre.
